Arguments Supporting Abortion

- A legal abortion has very small risk to the mother's health.

Pro Life Response

- An abortion can result in severe medical complications later in life; such as doubling the risk of ectopic pregnancy as well as the increase chance of a miscarriage pelvic and inflammatory disease increases.

Arguments Supporting Abortion

- A woman's right to choose abortion is a "fundamental right"- my body: my choice.
- Abortion is better than a child to live as unwanted, abused and neglected.

Pro Life Response

- Abortion conflicts with the unborn child's unalienable rights. Nobody should have the right terminate a life.
- A parent that kills his own child is prosecuted for murder ~ abortion is murder. Anyone that abuses or neglects their child is charged and could be sent to jail.

Arguments Supporting Abortion

- A legal abortion is a relief to a woman and she is able to continue on with her life in the way she wanted: without a child.

Pro Life Response

- Women that have abortions have a:
- 59 percent increased risk for suicidal thoughts
- 61 percent increased risk for mood disorders
- 61 percent increased risk for social anxiety disorders
- 261 percent increased risk for alcohol abuse
- 280 percent increased risk for any substance use disorder
- A 2011 study showed women that had abortions are *160 percent more likely* than delivering women to be hospitalized for psychiatric treatment in the first 90 days following abortion or delivery

Pro Life

Preventing the Need For Abortion

- The most effective forms of birth control – even if used correctly – were only 90 percent effective 30 years ago.
- **HOWEVER** today the birth control pill, when taken correctly, is between 92% and 99% effective.
- Add redundant prophylactics (spermicide, condoms, sponges, etc.) that effectiveness increases to 99.99%.
- Additionally the Plan B pill, which blocks fertilization, can be added for additional protection of unwanted pregnancy.

- According to the Gallup 56% of people agree that abortions should only be legal in very few situations
- 47% of people believe that abortion is morally wrong
