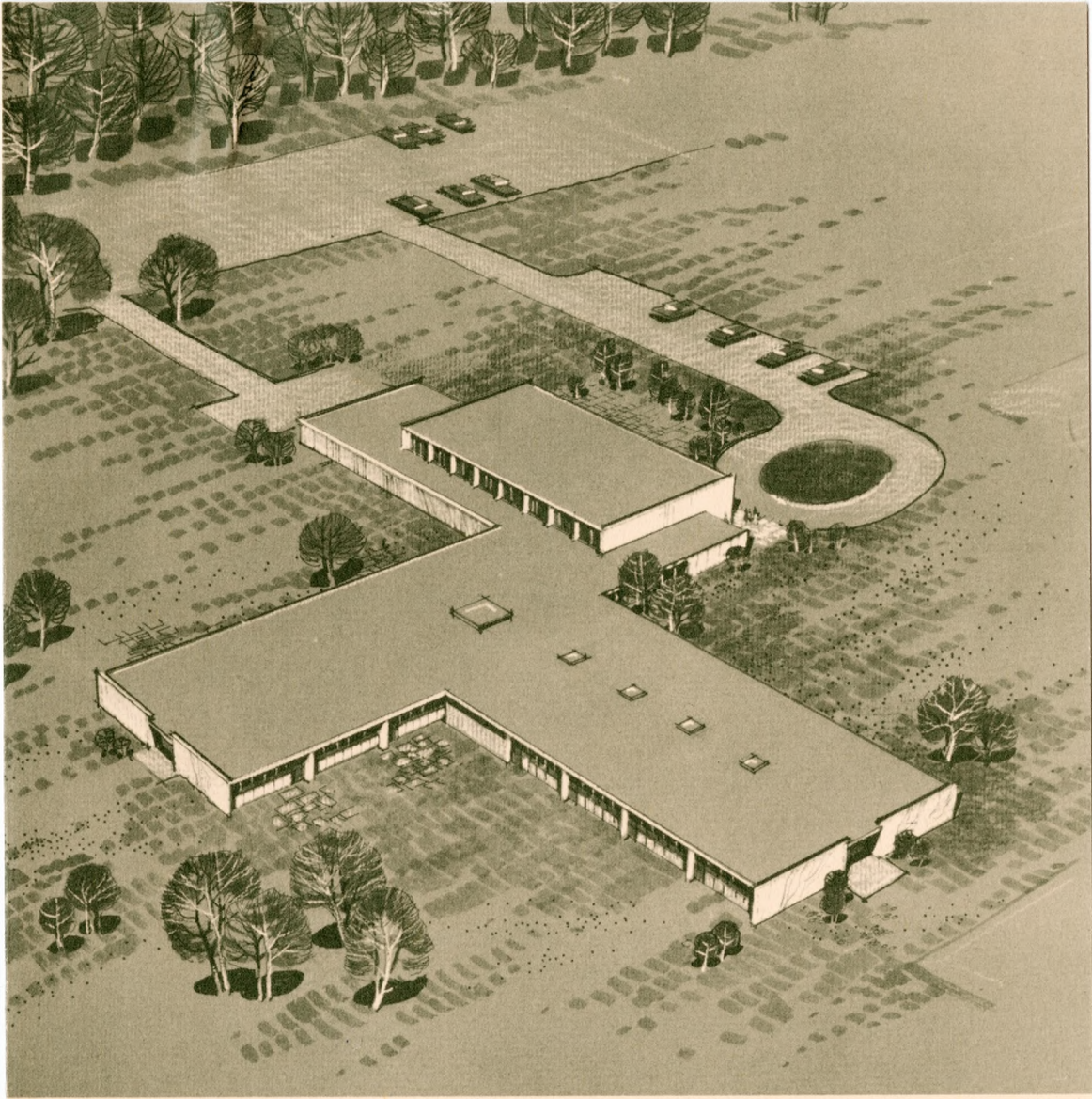

## PURPOSE

The Miami Valley School intends to strive for excellence in teaching and in the performance of its students. Its purpose is predicated to one of the most essential goals of American education—that our leaders of tomorrow must be properly challenged, trained to think, and stimulated to assume responsibility in their communities and in the nation.

The Miami Valley School represents the determination of many people in the greater Dayton area to maintain an outstanding independent school which will provide challenging academic courses as well as inspirational activities and healthful sports programs for the capable children of the region.

The school, of course, will not be tax supported, so it will charge tuition to meet its expenses. Acknowledging that not all families who might wish to provide such an opportunity for their youngsters can afford the full tuition, the school provides scholarship assistance for qualified candidates as funds are available.

The Miami Valley School is organized as a non-profit educational corporation with a Board of Trustees responsible for its operation.
