- **Communication barrier** along with education barrier for refugees students.



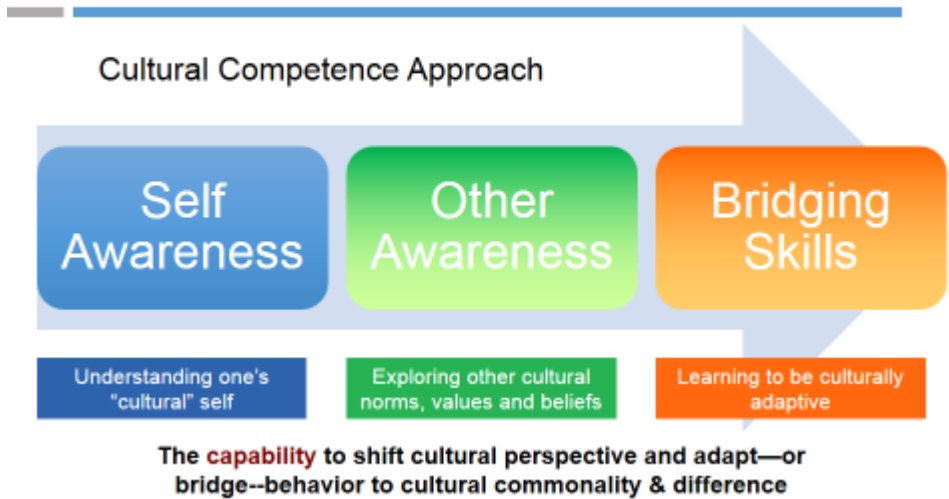
Addressing Problems in Education
