Camp near Corinth Miss, June 1st 1862

My dear Cousin Mattie,

Yours of the
11th ult, was only received to day, being
the first letter I have had from
you, for months, the mail have
been very irregular indeed. I am
now in excellent health, have
just returned from Corinth,
which you know is evacuated.
I have not time to write
particulars, you will have read
all before this time in the
public Journals. I am visiting
by a poor candle at the Guard
House, being all day there.

I understood we are to
come here to morrow, for
what point; I cannot say,
tho' I would drop you
a line while I could. Direct
your letters as heretofore.
Write soon to your Cousins,
pardon this short scetch,
