Sinclair Community College

Campus Ministry continues growing in its outreach to the Sinclair Community College community. Our ministry at Sinclair focuses its efforts through an ecumenical staff of a Roman Catholic priest and a Protestant seminary student working in behalf of the Dayton Area Campus Ministry.

The Campus Ministry Center is located on the third floor of the Business and Technology building at 5316. The Center offers an atmosphere for counseling, small discussion groups and referral services. Current announcements and campus ministry notices are posted on the door bulletin board at 5316.

Wright State University

The Campus Ministry Center is an ecumenical facility serving as a base for the Campus Ministry. Built by the Catholic Archdiocese, the Center is also referred to as the "Newman Center". The Center is open as a place to drop in, to relax and enjoy interesting conversation and quiet. It provides a flexible lounge area and offices for the Campus Ministry Team. The Center also maintains a borrowing library, collections of periodicals and articles on religious and social topics, and extensive files of organizations and involvements that may interest people. It is located in the wooded area just across the parking lot from Allyn Hall.
