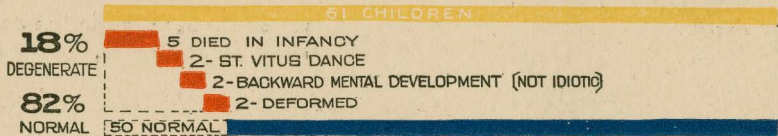

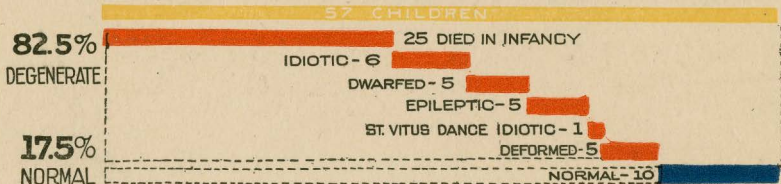

An interesting confirmation of the results obtained by Dr. Demme is the finding of Prof. C. F. Hodge of Clark University in his experiments with dogs. The comparison is shown by the following table:

NUMBER OF PROGENY NORMAL AND ABLE TO LIVE

	Alcoholized	Normal	
OF DOGS,	17.4%	90.2%	(Prof. Hodge's Experiment)
OF MEN,	17.5%	88.5%	(Prof. Demme's Investigation)

The case of the dogs indicates that the inferiority of drinkers' children was not due to poorer hygienic conditions among intemperate families, since all of the dogs received the best of care.
