Yellow Spring Novth 30 1862

Dear Brother

This is Sunday evening
and I'm studying and Mother gone
down to Mr Wilsons to see Mrs
Wilson she is very sick they don't
think she will live long, Charley has
enlisted in the 44th and has been
sick ever since Mr Wilson is going
to start after him this week. ^{Mrs}
Ginn was here this afternoon to get us
to direct a letter she has not heard
from John for some time I guess
Mr Ginn is as bad as ever he has

off and gone to Columbus. We get a letter
from Cousin Mary the other end of

Warner is coming home she sent us
his photograph he does not look
any thing like I thought he did,
Mrs May gets a letter from Mr May and
she said he would be home this month

Beeds are looking for Nat home he
wrote that he was coming home

in about two weeks that has some
time ago and he has not come yet
I guess you think we are pretty scarce
of paper from the looks of my letters

Well I must close, farewell good
night.
