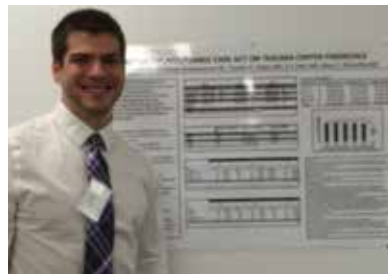

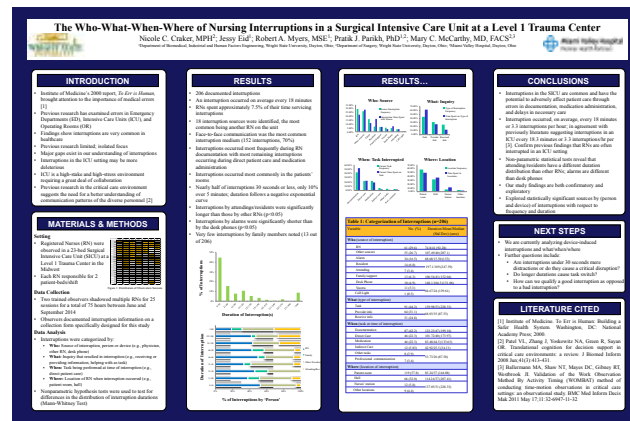
Residents
