Fully-Funded ACS Clinical Scholar Research Position for Residents

Applications are being accepted for a fully-funded Clinical Scholar in Residence position at the American College of Surgeons. The ACS and John A. Hartford Foundation (JAHF) are supporting a named, two-year clinical research position, the James C. Thompson Geriatric Surgical Fellowship, starting July 1, 2016. Work will be targeted toward evaluating and improving the care and outcomes of elderly persons undergoing surgery. The scholar will assist the ACS and JAHF in their newly funded initiative to develop a geriatric surgery quality improvement program. The scholar will work within the Division of Research and Optimal Patient Care at the ACS headquarters in Chicago and have the opportunity to perform research relevant to ongoing ACS quality projects. In addition to supporting salary, benefits, and other expenses, the fellowship also includes funding for the scholar to obtain a master's degree in health services and outcomes research at Northwestern University.

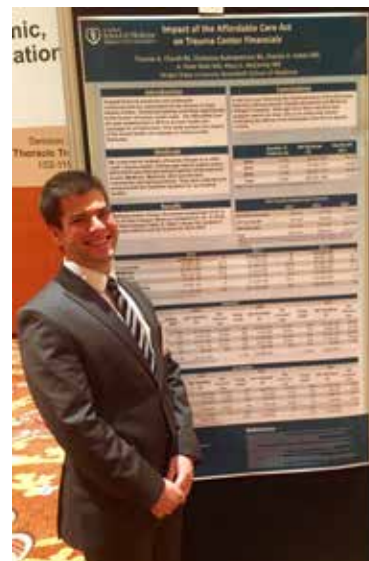
Applicants who have completed two or more years of clinical training, are in good standing with their program and the ACS, and are United States citizens are encouraged to apply.

Timothy F. Brewer, M.D., M.P.H., presented “Essential procedures: The need for expanding surgery’s role in global health,” at the Surgical Grand Rounds on September 9, 2015. Dr. Brewer is the vice provost, interdisciplinary and cross campus affairs, for the University of California, Los

Angeles. He also serves as the chair of the board of directors for the Consortium of Universities for Global Health. His research interests focus on prevention and control of multiple drug-resistant tuberculosis, global risk factors for emerging diseases, and the improvement of world-wide outbreak surveillance programs.
