We received yours
of the 27th to day and were very much
pleased and interested in the perusal
of it. so you have been to the Capital
and saw all the great things that are
to be seen there well I should have
liked to have seen them too. but I dont
suppose I ever shall but I like to hear
about them. how far are you from
Washington and how did you go did you
walk or ride and did you go alone
how is your health and the health of
the Reg. what do you do with your old
clothes when you get new ones. you say
I have never to you the amount of
that Note and interest. I have but
you may not have received it. but
I will tell you again. the Note
calls for one hundred and two dollars

what the interest is I dont know.
I got Mr Ellis to go and see the
the State and the Lawyer. and have
not heard from him yet I am looking
for a letter every day and as soon as I
get word I will write you again
I am sorry you dont get the papers we
send you we have sent two Frank
Leslies and two Harpers and I will
mail another Frank Leslie to day
do you get the daily papers and if so
what ones. School will be out
in three weeks. I expect Mary will
Teach this Summer. She has the
promise of a School over by Enon
Allie would like to go to College next
Term but I dont know how it will
be. if I can keep my Boarders next
Term I will do so. if my arm gets
strong enough to do the work and
you are willing I will have her go.
dont you think you will get a
furlough to come home this Spring?

Channing White was up last week
he is looking very well. Mr Herman
has taken a liking to him and is
Boarding Clothing and Schooling him
free gratis dont you think that is
doing pretty well for a Jew? but you
must not let Channing know that I
told you Herman wants it kept
secret his own family know nothing
about it. I am glad you got ~~you~~ some
Photographs taken the Girls can hardly
wait till they get here. how many
did you have taken can you send
more than one I should like to
send some to our friends who have
not seen you since you was a
little Boy. I am glad you are going
to write to Mag. I will give you
her name Margaret C. Fish her
address is Layrange Indiana She
will be very much pleased to get
a letter from you She speaks of you
in all her letters to us. perhaps you

can send her your Photograph
I have nothing of interest to
write so I guess I will close. the
Girls will write in a day or two.
