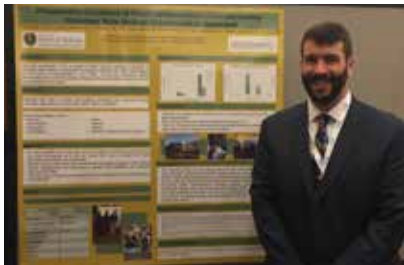

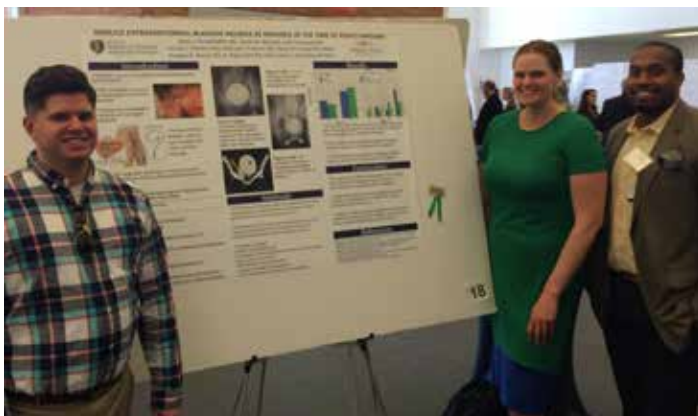

The Wright State University eighth annual Medical Student Research Symposium was held on April 13, 2016. The Department of Surgery represented eight posters at the event.



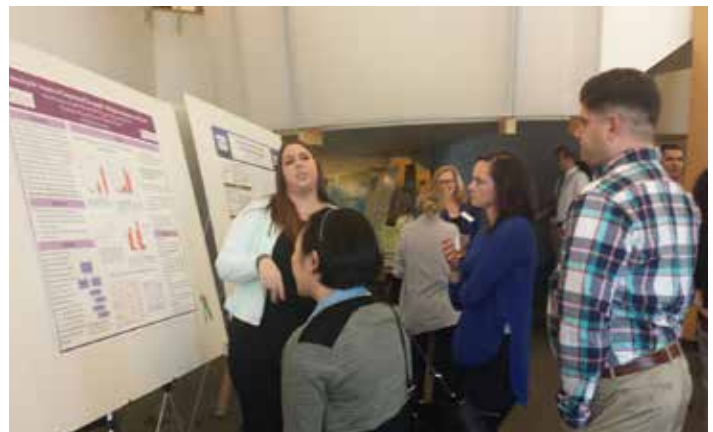
