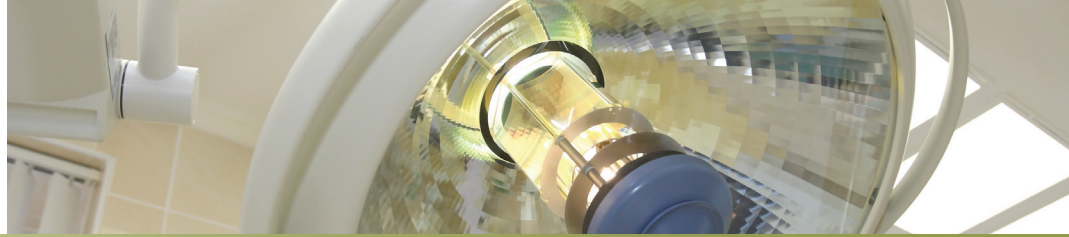

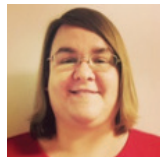
Match day was March 17. We look forward to welcoming our incoming residents!
