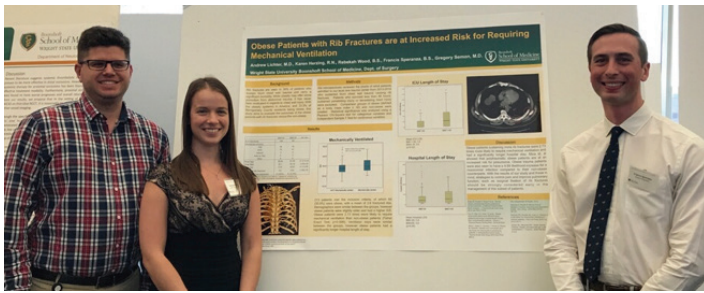
Distinguished Scholar Awards
