Thursday, January 5 Call at B.F. Witt's. His mother there. Got a card from home Busy taking down addresses for *Leaflet & Star*. Go to Witt's office and write for a clergyman's permit on J. Mad. & Ind. R.R. Preach at 7:30 Ps 16:8. Stay at W.G. Rubush's 409 Park Ave.

Friday, January 6 Spend forenoon at T.J. Connor's, 517 Alabama St. Dine at Moses Hatfield's, on East Street. Go down town with Moses H. Call at Jon't. Elliott's Office. Go to Bro. Wilmore's. Go with Moses Hatfield to Robert Park Chapel to the revival services conducted by Harrison. Stay at Bro. Wilmore's.

Saturday, January 7 Go on 8:30 M. train from Mass. Ave. Depot to New Britton. Call at Mrs. Mary Frazier's. Pr. at 10:30 Matt. 13:31. Dined at John Crosley's. Pr. at 2:00 Ps. 16:8. Qr. Conference. Supper at Mrs. Frazier's. Rev. A. Noyer pr. at 6:30 on prayer. I stay at Sister Frazier's. Half rainy thawing day. John & Henry Frazier, her sons.

Monday, February 27 Go to Mother Schildknecht's and stay till morning meeting. Excellent morning meeting—about 30 present. Dine at David E. Mullen's at toll-gate at Dublin pike. Went over to Rev. O. Jennings. Supper there Mother Lydia Sexton came. Stay at Ezra Schildknecht's

Tuesday, February 28 Go on 8:04 train home. See Rev. Mr. Warbington & Bro. Poffensbarger on the train. Spend the day largely in mailing papers.

Wednesday, March 1 Receive *Star* subscription and words of cheer from Revs. W.N. Coffman & I.M. Tharp. Write postals to several requesting articles for *Star*.

Thursday, March 2 Samuel Horine came in the morning & staid till the next day. Went in the evening to the Depot to inquire what trains stop at Philadelphia, Ind.

Friday, March 3 Went on 7:15 train to Philadelphia, Ind. Arrived at Philadelphia at 9:20. Bro. John Parker came for me on horseback. Dined at Parker's. Went on to Union Church. Call at Wm. Wilson's. Prayer and speaking meeting at 7:00. Rev. T.J. Halsted there. Some arose for prayer. Stay at Wm. Wilson's

Saturday, March 4 Went over to A.B. Rumler's. Demumbrun, Geo Wilson, and Rev. T.J. Halsted there. Dined. Pr. at 2:00, I Thes. 5:13. Qr. Conf. Felix jar with Macedonia Brethren. Supper at Jas. H. Murphy's—an aged exhorter Rev. T.J. Halsted preached at 7:00. I stay at Rumler's. Halsted's fatherinlaw is John Apple—step fatherinlaw.

Sunday, March 5 Went to Wm. Wilson's. Pr. at 10:30, Acts 24:15, Sarah Halsted. Communion service. Dine at Wm. Wilson's Went with Sameul Brooks to Mt. Zion, 11 miles. Pr. Acts 26:28, to a good-sized congregation. Stay at Bro. S. Brook's two miles north of McCordsville. Church is Mt. Zion 3 1/2 ms N. by East from McCordsville.

A.C. Wilmore's. Saw Father Muth & daughter on train. Also Rev. S. Frazee of Fayetteville. McNew pr. at Carrolton at 7:15. I exhort. Stay at Rev. Geo Muth's—aged 83.

Saturday, March 11 Pr. at 10:30 Ps. 84:11. Few out. Go to Father Muth's for dinner. Quarterly Conference. Few out. Supper at Muth's. Conference about \$26.00 behind for year so far on preacher's salary. Father Muth & Alfrey's

[unreadable] in Quarterly Conference. Father G. Muth before he embraced religion took seven degrees of Freemasonry. Says Morgan & Kernard correctly reveal it. Pr. at 7:15, Acts 26:28.

Sunday, March 12 Pr. at 10:30 Heb. 13:14. Dine at Emanuel Matilla's, it being his birth-day. Supper at Rev. A.C. Rice's with Rev. Z. McNew. Bro. McNew and Muth also dined at Matillo's. Bro. McNew preached at 7:15 Rev. 22:17 Bro McNew & myself lodge at Daniel Muth's, one mile S.E.

Monday, March 13 Went up to Carrollton and stopped at Rev. g. Muth's till toward noon. Went to A. Alfry's & dined. Remained till 4:00. Then Went up to Rev. G. Muth's & staid till meeting. Pr. at 7:15 from Ez. 33:11. Stay at Rev. G. Muth's.

Tuesday, March 14 Went in buggy with Rev. G. Muth to Greenfield, and on 11:30 train to Richmond. Susan took a hemorrhage (bronchial perhaps) in the evening. Went and got medicine of Dr. Hibberd.

Wednesday, March 15 At home all day. Susan feeble.

Thursday, March 16 At home all day. Susan gaining a little. Mrs. Abert (our nearest neighbor) called in.

Friday, March 17 Susan gaining a little. Caroline Zeller came in. At home all day. Did not start to my quarterly meeting on account of Susan's sickness. Wrote to Bro. Tharp. Had written him before.

Saturday, March 18 At home all day. Caroline came in afternoon again.

Sunday, March 19 Went to hear Rev. Henry Rupe at Baptist Church. "For me to live is Christ." Go to hear Rev. Clark Skinner preach at 7 1/2. He is P.E. M.E. Church. He preached at Grace M.E. Ch. Good ability but defective scholarship.

Tuesday, March 21 At home as usual. Susan still gaining. Emma Zeller called in. John & Martha Shearer called to see us. Proofs on Star sent in.

Wednesday, March 22 Read proofs and take them to

Telegram office. Emma Zeller called in. Went to see the doctor whom I had called to see several times since Susan's sickness. Mamie Albert called in awhile.

Thursday, March 23 Finished up furnishing copy, read proofs, and got April Star to press—outside pages. Caroline Zeller came in afternoon awhile. Went at 7:45 to depot. Stay at Cambridge City, Samuel Wright's.

Friday, March 24 Went on 5:35 train to Columbus, Ind., Joseph King, who came after me, failed to find me. Called at C.N. Spencer's. Called at his house a half hour. Had dined at Eating house. Hunted a way to Salt Creek. Saw Young Sol. Vonncida, Redman, Mench, Beam. Go with Isaack [sic] King. Stay at Josh. Guffey's.

Saturday, March 25 Wrote in forenoon. Dine at Guffey's. Pr. at 2:00 Ps. 16:11. Quarterly Conf. Supper at Joseph Ohaver's with Bros. Rice & Crawford. Rev. A.H.K. Beam Pr. at 7 1/2 o'clock from Nahum 1:7. Stay at John Kings, with Rice and Crawford's.

Sunday, March 26 Pr. at 10 1/2. Heb. 13:14. Sacramental service. Dine at Joseph H. Overhaver's. Pretty day, though threatening rain. Preach at 7:30, I John 3:2. 15 or 20 out. Stay at Bro. Ohavers.

Monday, March 27 Went on to Columbus Called at Charley Spencer's. Went on 10:30 train to Indianapolis. Called at Rev. A.C. Wilmore's; also at Rev. T.J. Connor's. Went on 4:45 train home Found family well except wife, and she improving.

Tuesday, March 28 Tuesday do much writing.

Wednesday, March 29 Finish nearly the matter for April Star. Read some proof.

Thursday, March 30 Read up proofs and oversee make up of paper in afternoon. Saw Floyd & Hutchens, and Henry Franklin Star subscribers to-day.

Friday, March 31 Paper went to press. Paid F.M. Demembrun's tax \$6.28—using road-receipt of 56 cts. Mailed the Star to regular subscribers. Paid Cock Co. \$21.00. Went on the evening (8:10) train to Cambridge City. Staid at Central Hotel.

Saturday, April 1 Went on 5:35 train to St. Louis Crossing & Hope. Reuchlin came for me. Dine at President's. Pr. at 2:00, I John 3:2. Qr. Conf. Suppe at Funkhouser's. Pr. at 7:30 Jude 21v. Stay at Nathaniel Miller's. Mrs. Milo Bailey & daughter were on the train to Columbus to see Lawrence Bailey's wife who was very sick.

Sunday, April 2 Pr. at 10:30, Ps 137:6. About 800 people at Church. Dine at P. Rawlins. Taught S.S. class. Call at the president's & take supper at Josiah Lawrence's. Pr. at 7:30, I Cor. 5:7. Stay at Isaac Vansickle's.

Monday, April 3 Reuchlin & Lorin invited to Breakfast with me. Am at morning prayers at the College. Call at John Anderson's & Mother Fixes & Mother Coblentz & Scudders. Dine at Rev. W.C. Day's. Get horse & buggy & Pres. Kiracofe takes me to Hope. Go on via St. L. Cr. & Cambridge home. Find all well.

Friday, April 7 Write some letters. Went on 8:10 evening train to Cambridge City. Stay at Central Hotel.

Saturday, April 8 Went on to Laurel. Rev. A.J. Bolen met me and took me to Andersonville. Dine at Bolen's. Pr. at 2:00, Jude 21st. v. Supper at Rev. John Morgan's, aged 81 this month. Preach at 7:30 Ps. 1:6. Stay at Dr. F.J. Spilman's.

This is the last number of the first volume of the *Leaflet*. It has carried to hundreds and even thousands of homes its brief message of anti-secrecy truth. It has done something toward awakening the people on the subject of Freemasonry, and secret societies in general. For the favor shown it the publisher desires to return his sincere thanks to its patrons.

It is a strange fact that violations of the decalogue, and the precepts of Christ, under the cover of secret organization are regarded by many Christian people as a harmless thing, while the same transgressions if perpetrated outside of the cover of secretism are regarded by them as most criminal. They laud the secret systematic violators of God's law; but discipline and excommunicate those who otherwise commit the same offense. It looks like they do not so much care that the law is violated, as they care for what people will say about it.

It is not so much what is done in the lodge, bad as this is, as what its members are taught. They are taught that the most horrid oaths are tolerable; that clans to take advantage of outsiders are right and desirable; that conscience can abdicate its scepter in favor of that of another; that craftiness and guile are virtues; and that men can take upon themselves obligations, unknown to the laws of God and of their country, which are above all civil obligations, and that bind closer practically than any ecclesiastical obligations. They are thus taught that the obligations of the lodge are more sacred than those of their country, so that they would prefer one of their own to an outsider, when acting for their country, and one of the lodge

to a non-lodge man, when acting for the church. There is no greater falsehood than that the lodge requires nothing inconsistent with one's duty to himself, to his country, or to his religion.

SECRETISM NOT INVINCIBLE

Freemasonry seems to claim that the sledge-hammer of truth and the sharp blade of logic can be directed against it only for its gain and glory. It sometimes boasts that it prospers most with opposition. Some are weak enough to credit its bold vauntings.

It is true that its protean form, as seen in its varieties of lodgedoms, has a large and well-disciplined host. It has a standing army of the best moonlight drill. It has its fortifications, and is well intrenched. It rules in the churches. It prevails in Congress, the legislatures, and the courts. It controls the schools. It either muzzles or dictates the utterances of the pulpit and the press. Is not all on its side! No! not all. God, truth, the larger portion of the church of Christ, and the great body of the people are against it. The facts of the present and the records of the past are against it in all its forms and with all its shams. There is a great fund of intelligence, conscience, moral influence, and wealth in the communion of anti-secretism. It is true that anti-lodge men need to be thoroughly aroused, inspired, drilled. They slumbered while secrecy — after a feigned death — was resuscitating, growing, drilling, and intrenching.

Anti-secrecy principles have commanded the first-class minds of America, both in church and in the nation. In proof of this we need but mention such names as Samuel Adams, William Wirt,
