Tuesday, January 1 Spent the day mostly in writing. Was at home all day except to go down to town on errands. Wrote up some editorial matter. My home was at Richmond, Indiana.

Wednesday, January 2 Sent some copy for *Star*. Read up proofs. Made up paper in afternoon. Papers all came at night, ready to mail.

Thursday, January 3 Called at Allen Harris' at D.K. Zeller's (paid Grandmother six dollars). Applied for half-fare passes at the depot. Papers (*Star*) were all mailed that day.

Friday, January 4 Started on 10:50 train via Anderson to Wabash. Make close connection and arrive at the latter place about 3:30. Bro. S.C. Sweet meets me and (after making affidavit to the marriage of T.W. & Paulina Modlin for pension purposes & seeing Chas. Rose) I went to South Wabash with him. Supper and lodging at Samuel C. Sweet's. Rev. D.E. Myers pr. at 6:30 Prayers followed. One arose for prayers.

Saturday, January 5 Remained at Bro. Sweet's till afternoon. Pr. at old M.E. Church at 2:00. Ps. 27:14. "Wait on th Lord." Quarterly conference. Pastor's salary came nearly up except no report from Lincolnville. Pleasant session. Supper at Bro. John N. Mills. Pr. at 6:30 from xHeb. 11:6. Good speaking meeting followed. Seveal (5) asked for prayers. Stay at Bro. Sweet's. x"Without faith—impossible to please God," etc.

Sunday, January 6 Pr. at 10.30 Ex. 28:34, "Golden bell." Communion follows. Dined at John Brown's. Saw Mr.

Pierson & wife (newly married) there. She Brown's daughter. Saw Mrs. Copick, also a daughter there. Called at Sweet's before meeting. Rev. D.E. Myers pr. at 6:30. I exhort. Large attendance & good attention. Stay at Sweet's.

Monday, January 7 Go after an early breakfast with Rev. D.E. Myers to depot as he goes home to Marion. Write several cards at the post-office. See Wm. L. Stone, an old school-mate of mine. His brothers Frank and Silas are dead. He lives next street west of the post-office. Return to S. Wabash and Dine at Benjamin H. Hutchins. Called toward night at Jac. Ridenour's & at Showalter's. Tea at Benj. H. Hutchens'. Pr at 6:30, Jer. 13:21. Stay at Benj. Kershner's 1 1/4 m S. West.

Tuesday, January 8 Meeting at Church at 10:00 Hutchens opened. Good meeting. Dine at Jacob Ridenour's. Long talk in afternoon. Supper at S.C. Sweets. Pr at 6:30, Acts 26:28. Several arose for prayers & four came to the altar. Stay at S.C. Sweets.

Wednesday, January 9 Wrote a few cards. Had forenoon meeting. One arose for prayer—Mrs. Florence Kershner—& joined church professing conversion today. Another backsliden one knelt & prayed for herself. Rev. J. Heavenridge and Raferd Copeland came. Dine at Jas. N. Mills. Went to Wabash—got a letter from home—wrote some cards—called at Wm. L. Stone's, an old school mate, much my senior. Supper at Br. Sweets. Pr. at 6:30 Ez. 33:11. Meeting blocked by disreputable characters coming to the front and arising for prayers. Stay at Benj. Kershner's.

Thursday, January 10 Morning meeting good. Miss Mable Jenks joined church. Dine at S.C. Sweet's with Rev. D.E. Myers, who had returned, and with Rev. J. Heavenridge & Raferd Copeland. Bros. Heavenridge and Copeland go home to Lincolnville. Stay at Sweet's till after 4:00. Supper at Brown's son-in-law's. Rev. D.E. Myers preached at 6:30 Heb. 2:1. I settle some bummers who had taken from seats for a few nights. Stay at S.C. Sweet's.

Friday, January 11 Went on 10:00 train to Marion. Silvanus C. Thomas meets me. He takes me to post-office and thence home with him. He lives 3 miles S.W. of Marion on Liberty pike. Pr. at Liberty at 6:30, Luke 24:46. Stay at Silvanus C. Thomas's.

Saturday, January 12 Stay at Silvanus C. Thomas's till after dinner. Pr. at Liberty Church at 2:00 Ps. 27:14. Qr. Conf. followed. Supper Isaac Reynolds' 1/2 m. West. Pr. at 6:30, Matt. 13:44. Stay at Bro. Reynold's.

Sunday, January 13 Pr. at 10:30 at Liberty Ex. 28:34. Sacramental meeting. Dine at Geo. Carter's 2 m N.E. of Jonesboro with John Y. Parlett & with Wm. Carter & wife. Call in afternoon at Bro. Carter's soninlaw, Enos Bond's, and at Henry Carter's, Solomon Carter's there. Pr. at Liberty at 6:30, Mark 8:36. Stay at Henry Carter's.

Monday, January 14 Called at George Carter's. Borrow a little funds of Mrs. (Mary) Carter. George takes me to depot at Jonesboro (Harrisburg). Go via Ridgeville to Richmond. Arrive at home at half hour late. Harrisburg is called Gas City, now.

Tuesday, January 15 Go to Wm'sburg with Reuchlin. Pr. Thomas Cranor's funeral. He an old friend. A good citizen and church member. Dine at Madison Cranor's. Get home a little after dark.

Thursday, January 17 Read up proofs and in the afternoon make up the *Star*, first side.

Friday, January 18 G on 10:50 train to Kokomo. Arrive about 2:00 Go out to Vermont, Rev. I. Cox meets me & takes me to David Markland's. I Pr. at Bethany Church at 6:30, Luke 15:7, dwelling on 1 Sin 2 Repentance 3 Joy over deliverance Stay at Markland's.

Saturday, January 19 Pr. at 10:30 at Bethany, Isa. 40:31. Dine at Hugh Johnson's with James Boyer & Wm. Bowden of North Grove. Qr. Conference at 1:30 (2:00) Brief session. Supper at J. William Kester's 1 1/4 mile east. Rev. I. Cox pr at 6:30, Gen. 3:9, "Where art thou?" I exhorted. Stay at David Markland's.

Sunday, January 20 Pr. at 10:30, at Bethany, 2 Cor. 7:1, "Perfecting," etc. Communion followed. Dined at David Smith's 2 1/4 m. south-west. Attended meeting at Vermont (M.E.) and heard Rev. Mr. Knox preach. Went back to Smith's. Rev. I. Cox pr at Bethany Isa. 55:6, "Seek the Lord," etc. Four came forward for prayers. Two joined church. C. Swafford & Mrs. Johnson Stay at D. Markland's.

Monday, January 21 Love-feast Meeting at 10:30. Good meeting. Bro. Cox spoke warmly of his experience and love for the Church. Dined at Aaron Brown's Bro. Cox nearly sick. I pr. at 6:30. Jer. 13:21. Bro. Cox exhorted earnestly and for 25 minutes, his last. I stay at Jas. Wm. Kester's.

Tuesday, January 22 Went over to Chris. Swafford's. Found Bro. Cox quite unwell. He ate a little dinner and lay down again. About one o'clock he had an apoplectic attack. Easier after a while but weak. Conscious all the time till midnight & thence unconscious till he died at 4:00 next morning. I preached at 6:30 Mark 8:36. Jas. Wm. Hester & wife joined Church.

Wednesday, January 23 Went to David Smith's, and thence to Kokomo, to get Coffin, Burial suit, etc. Telegraph to friends. Dined at David Smith's. Went over to Swafford's. Short service at the Bethany Church, funeral. Go on with Mrs. Matilda Ann Cox David Smith & Sophia Smith & the corpse to Kokomo & thence to Indianapolis. Stay at the Pile House.

Thursday, January 24 Went on 7:25 train to Greenwood, & thence to Rev. Irvin Cox's late residence, 4 miles south-west. Dine at L. Washington Jones. Rev. Z. McNew & wife there. McNew is his soninlaw. Call at Mrs. Cox's. Pr. at Honey Cr. at 7:00. Rom. 4:8. Mrs. Meritbox delivered a message to me. Told of her revelations. Evidently insane. I stay at L.W. Jones.

Friday, January 25 Pr. Rev. Irvin Cox's funeral Prov. 14:32. "The righteous hath hope in his death." About two house-fulls. Rev. Z. McNew and P.B. Williams present, & Rev. Widmay & Noble of M.E. Church. Dine at Mrs. Cox's. Went in afternoon to Greenwood with Samuel Alexander. Go on 6:32 (6:40) train to Indianapolis. Stay at Rev. P.B. William's, 29 Plum Street.

Saturday, January 26 Went on 4:15 train to Anderson. Detained at Brightwood nearly an hour & thereby miss the Fairmount train. Write letters and an article at the depot. Go about 1:40 toward Fairmount. Walk down to Robt. Hastings Witt Hastings gets me a horse & buggy, and I go out to Bro. Ruboldt's 1/2 mile east of Knox Chapel. Supper there. I pr at 6:30 at Knox chapel (1 1/2 mile S.E. of Point Isabel) Rom. 4:8. Stay at Rybolt's.

Sunday, January 27 Pr. at 10:30 John 14:2. Communion follows. Dine at Aquilla Day's. They have 12 children. I Pr. at 6:30, John 15:22, by request of Wallace Titus. My throat quite sore and I become quite hoarse. I stay at Wallace titus's. Have fever and then sweat at night.

Monday, January 28 Titus takes me over to Day's, and Young Day takes me on to Connor Clymer's where we dine and then on to Elwood. Saw Daniel Clymer at Connor's. He believes the world flat and square with four corners! Saw Rev. O.E. Evans at Elwood. Came home on 2:00 train. Found all as well as common.

Tuesday, January 29 At home. Considerably unwell. Sore throat and feverish. Did a little editorial work. Found myself unable to do much with whatever of effort.

Wednesday, January 30—Tuesday, February 5 At home. Too unwell to do much of anything.—Unable to do any editorial work.—Unable to write to any advantage.—Still unwell. . . .—Wrote some for the *Star*.

Wednesday, February 6 Finished editorial writing, for the *Star*. Read up some proofs. Wrote several letters in the evening.

Thursday, February 7 Got the proofs. Made up the paper. Got the paper out just before night.

Friday, February 8 Went on the 10:17 train to New Castle & thence to Muncie. Saw John H. Smith (son of Wm.) formerly at Fayetteville. Walked from Depot to 1 m north of Muncie. Then rode in a buggy with a Mr. Acre to Joshua Null's 1 m east of Bethel. Stay there that night. Joshua had moved back from near 1/4 m Baxter Springs in Southern Kansas.

Saturday, February 9 Wrote letters to T.J. Burns of Casey, Iowa and C.S. Mosher of 719 Balt. St., Baltimore, Maryland. Joshua takes me a-horse-back to New Corner. Dine at Fred. Huber's. Pr. at 2:00 Gal. 4:18. Qr. Conf. followed. Pleasant Conference supper at J. Wesley Brock's near church. Pr. at 7:00, Ps. 16:8. Stay at David Nantz's. It is a very muddy time.

Sunday, February 10 Pr. at New Corner at 10:30, Ex. 28:34. Dine at Frederick Huber's, & stay till evening meeting. Pr. at 6:30, Rom. 12:1, "Your reasonable service." Stay at J.W. Brock's, 3/4 mile north of town. It Sleets a little that night.

Monday, February 11 Speaking meeting at 10:00. Pretty good. Dine at J. Wesley Brooks Stay till evening meeting at Brook's. Pr. at 7:00, Matt. 6:33. Fair congregation despite mud and some rain. Stay at Frederick Huber's. Was with Rev. J.M. Cook, the pastor, from the quarterly conference till I left for home.

Tuesday, February 12 Bro. Huber takes me to Muncie. Some rain in the last few miles of the way. Stay at the depot till train time. Go on to New Castle & thence home. Arrive near 5:00. My home was in Richmond, Indiana.

Thursday, February 14 At home. Did some writing of letters. Felt very nervous in the evening. Symptoms such as I never had before, for a day or two past. Whether from nervous exhaustion, spinal irritation, cold in my head, or biliousness, I cannot tell.

Sunday, February 17 Attended services at the Baptist Church and heard Rev. Allen preach a brief but good discourse on 1 Cor. 3:9. The morning was a rainy one. In the evening attended services at Grace Church. Mr. Craft pr.

Tuesday, February 19 Spent the day at home in writing. Reuchlin went on a visit to D. Koerner's and A. Moor's.

Saturday, February 23 Went to Dublin on 3:00 aft. train. Call at Rev. J. Cranor's. Stay at Wilson Scroggy's.

Sunday, February 24 Call at Rev. H. Floyd's & at Rev. Wm. Oler's & Prof. J. Cranor's. Attend class-meeting at United Brethren Church, led by [blank] a faith doctor. A humbug. Dine at Rev. J. Cranor's. Pr. at U.B. Ch. at 7:00, Ps. 16:8. Stay at Dr. G.W. Champ's.

Monday, February 25 Call at Edmond Wilson's 1/4 mile west of town. At Wm McGeath's and at Aunt Betsy Witt's. Dine at Gray's. Go home on 1:20 train. Reuchlin on same train with bad toothache which continued till following Saturday with swelling of his face. It gathered and broke on the inside of his mouth.

Tuesday, February 26 Worked on editorials.

Friday, February 29 Made up *Star* in forenoon. Began to mail papers. Samuel Wright spent the night with us.

Saturday, March 1 Continued to mail the *Star*. Finished about noon. Samuel left in the forenoon. I missed the 7:40 train to Dayton.

Sunday, March 2 Mrs. W. & Myself went to Baptist Church. Heard the pastor Mr Allen preach. Did not go to meeting in the evening.

Monday, March 3 Went to Dayton on the early train. Stopped at Day's & Dr. Davis'. Dined at the latter place. Saw Dr. J.P. Landis. Called at Dillon's and Day's. Meeting of Ex. Com. of Board of Education at 3:30. Supper at Rev. W.C. Day's. Stay at Henry Recker's with Lorin.

Tuesday, March 4 Came home on morning train. Geo. Croly (on his way to Portland, Oregon) called. Rev. C.B. Small visited us & I went with him to Allen M. Harris'. Isaac Huddleston's & Peter Albert's. Afternoon went to John Roberts' with Small.

Thursday, March 6 Went on 11:00 train to Bryant. Walk out to Samuel Read's. Stay there. Cousin Sarah E. Worth also there.

Friday, March 7 Dined at Aaron Worth's. Went in the afternoon with Cyrus Hills to Dillon P. Smith's. Rev. Wm. Hall pr. at Gilead at 7:30. I exhort. Lodge at Smith's.

Saturday, March 8 Staid at Bro. Smith's till meeting at 1:30. Pr. Matthew 11:30. Pleasant qr. conf. followed. Supper at P. Drey's. Rev. M.M. Thomas pr. at 7:00. Stay at Cyrus C. Paxon's that night.

Sunday, March 9 I was at the morning meeting. Preached at 10:30. 2 Cor. 3:8. Dine at Dillon P. Smith's with Saml. Read & family and Audion Worth. Rev. Wm. Hall pr at 7:00, I exhort at some length. Stay at C.C. Paxon's.

Monday, March 10 Call at Father Wm. Dugdale's. Dine at Cyrus Paxon's. Go to Camden with Cline. Stay at the store with Rev. Wm. Hall till Rev. M.M. Thomas came and took me to Lichtenfels'. East Supper there. Go on to Pleasant Dale School-House. Pr. at 7:30, Rom. 14:17. Stay at G.W. Wyandt's.

Tuesday, March 11 Rev. M.M. Thomas takes me to Hartford through the rain. Go on to Upland. Dine at Robert Wright's. Go on to Jonesboro on 3:30 train. Ride with "Buck" Ice to Uncle W.H.H. Reeder's. Muddy and dark tramp of 1/4 mile from cross-roads to the house! Lodge at Reeder's.

Wednesday, March 12 Go over to the farm. Mr. McShay is gathering corn. One third of mine ungathered! Return to W.H.H. Reeder's. Stay till morning.

Thursday, March 13 W.H.H. Reeder, Jr. takes me to the train, quite early. Just in time. Go to Jonesboro. Stay there at Hiram Simons' till train time. Go to Hartford. Rev. N.L. Hoopingarner meets me & takes me to George Stallsmith's. Dinner and supper there. Pr. at Carney's Sch. H. at 7:30. Gal. 6:14. Stay at Stallsmith's.

Friday, March 14 Stay at Stallsmith's till evening. Studying mental philosophy (Joseph Haven's) Pr. at Carney's Sch. H. John 1:29. Stay at Stallsmith's. Sit up with N.L. Hoopingarner till nearly 2:00. He quite sick.

Saturday, March 15 Stay at Stallsmith's till afternoon. Pr. at 1:30 (2:00) Luke 10:29. Quarterly conf. followed

Pleasant session. But reports were short. Supper at Stallsmith's. Pr at 7:30, John 3:7. Stay at Stallsmith's.

Sunday, March 16 Pr. at 10:30, Luke 16:31. Communion followed. Dine at J.W. Stallsmith's, 3/4 mile N.W. of Hartford. Pr. at 7:15, Ps. 87:3. At the close give some history of the Church. Stay at J.W. Stallsmith's.

Monday, March 17 After an early dinner, went to Hartford. Took 12:30 train for Ridgeville & thence home.

Thursday, March 20 Read up the remainder of *Star* proofs and made up the outside.

Friday, March 21 Went on 10:37 train to New Castle and thence to Montpelier. Rev. I.M. Tharp meets me and takes me to Mt. Zion in Wells Co. Supper at Tharp's. Pr. at "Bethel" (in Mt. Zion) at 7:30 Isa. 55:1. "Ho every one that thirsts," etc. Stay at Tharp's.

Saturday, March 22 Stay at Tharp's till after dinner. Bro. Amos Alspach came about 10:30. Dine at Rev. I.M. Tharp's. Pr. at 2:00 I Pet 2:6-9 Qr. Conf. followed, pleasant & good. Supper at Thomas Clampet's. Rev. W.C. Ketner pr. at 7:30, Heb. 11:14. Large congregation. Good meeting. Stay at Thos. Clampet's, 3/4 m. North.

Sunday, March 23 Pr. at 10:30 2 Cor. 3:7-8. Communion followed. Dine at Geo. Gaizer's with Jac. Cockran, Abr. Matthias, etc. Slept an hour in the afternoon. Pr. at 7:30 I Pet. 4:18. A very large congregation. Stay at Wm. Pearce's in town.

Monday, March 24 Went with Tharp's to Elijah Morrison's. Dinner & supper there. John Beatty son of Robt. Beatty living there. Pr at 8:00, Rom. 10:1. Pretty large congregation. Stay at Rev. I.M. Tharp's.

Tuesday, March 25 It rained so that Bro. Tharp's and myself could not well go to Bro. Poling's to Dinner. Rode Bro. Tharp's horse to Buckeye and got a letter from home. Went on to David Elliot's 4 miles S.E. of Warren. It rained hard soon after I got there. Staid at Elliott's.

Wednesday, March 26 Bro. Elliott took me in a spring-wagon to James Coolman's across the Wabash River from Huntington. Very cold day. Dinner & Supper there.

Lodge there. They have a daughter, two sons & a babe.

Thursday, March 27 Bro. Jas. Coolman takes me over to Rev. Cyrus Smith's on the Etna Pike. Dinner there Sleep there an hour or two. Supper there. I Pr. at Pleasant Grove at 8:00, John 3:7. I Stay at Roland Z. Brown's.

Friday, March 28 Wrote some postal cards to Staward's on Marion Circuit. Slept nearly two hours before dinner. Dinner & Supper at Roland Z. Brown's. Conclude not to go to meeting on account of the rain. Lodge at Brown's.

Saturday, March 29 Went over to Mathias Dungan's & dined. Pr. at 2:00 at Pleasant Grove, Math 6:7. Qr. Conf. followed. Pleasant Session. Supper at Geo. Leverton's. Rev. C. Smith pr at 7:45, Eph. 2:22. Stay at Jesse Bunker's.

Sunday, March 30 I Pr. at 10:30, Jas. 1:12. Communion followed. Dine at Mart. Dungan's. Staid there till evening meeting. Pr. at 7:00, Rom. 3:5. Stay at Isaac Barker's on Etna pike, 2 1/2 miles S.W. of Huntington. He takes me to the 6:00 train next morning.

Monday, March 31 Go on early train to Ft. Wayne. Stay mostly at the depot, till 12:52 train to Richmond. Arrive at home about 5:00 Eve. Found all about in usual health.

Wednesday, April 2 Writing for paper. Read some proofs.

Thursday, April 3 Read up the remainder of proofs & made up the Editorial pages of the *Star*.

Friday, April 4 Paid my Richmond tax \$7.00. Went on 10:32 train to Ridgeville and thence to Marion. Stay at Rev. D.E. Myer's.

Saturday, April 5 Went on up to Wabash on 7:03 train, with Bro. Myers. Jacob Silvius meets me & takes me to his house—Mill creek appointment. Dine there. Pr. at 2:00, John 1:16, Qr. Conference followed. Pleasant Session. Pretty well attended. Supper at Enoch Shambaugh's, the son-in-law of Kesler. Rev. D.E. Myers pr. at 7:30, "Leaving the things which are behind," etc. Stay at Wm. Dubbois.

Sunday, April 6 Preach at Mill Creek Church at 10 1/2 Zech. 13:9. Dine at Kesler's with Rev. D.E. Myers. Pr. at 7:00, Mal. 4:1 "There Shall," etc. Stay at Wm. Dubois'.

Monday, April 7 Bro. Dubois takes me to Wabash. Go thence to Fairmount. Walk & ride out to Uncle Wm. Reeder's. Stay there.

Tuesday, April 8 Wrote out a contract for myself and McShays. Go over in the afternoon and get the contract signed. Stay at Reeder's.

Wednesday, April 9 Went across the river to Mr. Park's. Dined there. Returned. Sold Mr. Simons 250 bushels of corn and Joseph Pearl 25 bushels. Saw Wm. Leach & Joseph Corn. Went to Wm. Duling's. Called at Geo. Simon's and at Alma Reave's. Stay at Uncle Wm. Reeder's.

Thursday, April 10 Wrote out a duplicate of lease contract. Helped raise Wm's house. Rode over in Afternoon and had duplicate signed. Called at Simons and found John had gone back on the corn contract. Staid at Reeder's.

Friday, April 11 Staid at Uncle's till after dinner. Flora took me to Fairmount afternoon. Got a letter from Susan. She having a bad cold, but better. Went on cars to Jonesboro. Walk out to G. Carter's. Supper there. Walked on to D.E. Myers at Marion. Dr. Champ there. Staid at Myers'.

Saturday, April 12 Went to post-office Got a letter from Susan. She some better. Went on to Rev. Robt. W. Fryer's in North Marion. Rev. D.E. Myers comes and takes me to Jeff. Hanimaker's to dinner. He take me on nearly to Union Chapel. Pr at 2:00, John 1:16. Pleasant Qr. Meeting. Supper at Micaga Wesner's. She was Eliz. Woohman's. R.W. Fryer pr. at 7:30, "I am the light of the world." Stay at F.A. Bradford's.

Sunday, April 13 Pr. at 10 1/2 (Union) and Easter sermon, Acts 26:8. Communion followed. Dine at Micaga Wesner's. Call in the afternoon at Harvey M. Crevaston's. Rev. W.C. Ketner pr. at 7:00, "With one consent to make excuse."

Monday, April 14 Rev. J.Y. Demumbrun takes me to

Marion. Pay my tax, borrowing \$8.00. Go on 11:45 train to Ridgeville and thence home at 5:00. Read up my letters & prepared manuscript contributed for the *Star*.

Tuesday, April 15 Prepared copy for the *Star*. Went on 10:37 train to New Castle to the Ministerial Institute. Found my home at at [sic] Wm. C. Gowdy's, Father Jennings' son-in-law. Institute exercises continued. Rev. Wm. Dillon went to supper with me Rev. A. Rust pr. at 7:30. Stay at Gowdy's.

Wednesday, April 16 Institute continued. Rev. Z. McNew Dined with me. Institute continued. Rev. A.J. Bolen supped with me at Wm. C. Gowdy's. Rev. Wm. Dillon preached "In him was life, and the life was the light of men." Rev. W.C. Day staid with me at Mr. Gowdy's.

Thursday, April 17 Institute Continued Rev A.C. Wilmore dined with me. Supper at Harvey Root's Rev. Z. McNew preached at 7:30, 2 Cor. 5:17. I stay at W.C. Gowdy's.

Friday, April 18 Institute continued. Left of 11+ train for Kokomo. Stay at Kokomo narrow guage depot over two hours without fire. Caught a sharp cold in my head and throat. Went on to Vermont. Walked out to David Marklands, a mile North-east. Staid there till noon next day.

Saturday, April 19 Bro. David Markland takes me in a two horse wagon to Olive Branch 4 1/2 miles east to quarterly meeting pr. at 2:00, John 1:16. Quar. Conf. followed. Conf. aftee to retain Wm. Reeder's. Thence on 1:15 tr to Middletown. Daniel Rinker takes me to his house near Daleville. Call at Rev. J.M. Kabrich's & got a letter from Home. Supper at Rinker's with Rev. A.C. Wilmore & wife. Pr. Opening discourse before Woman's Branch Missionary Association Phi. 4:3. Stay at Daniel Rinker's, a half-mile east of Daleville.

Tuesday, April 22 Went after an early breakfast on 6:10 train to attend Malinda Day's funeral, wife of Rev. A.R. Day. I pr. at 10:00. Bury at Mt. Pleasant, 3 ms South of New Burlington. Short service at the Mt. Pleasant Church. Returned to Day's a half mile N.W. of Muncie. Stay there till morning. All the sons were at the funeral: Franklin, Wm. C., George, Harvey, Rufus.

Wednesday, April 23 Arose early and after an early lunch, Went to Lake Erie & Western Railroad depot. After some detention, start on local accom. train to Alexandria. Arrive there about 9:30. Mail some letters & cards. Lunch at restaurant. Go on 1:00 train to Fairmount. Cyrus Smith aboard. Walk over to Uncle W.H.H. Reeder's. Stay there.

Thursday, April 24 Stay at Uncle's till after dinner. Walked out to the fields & talked with Wm. Junior. Concluded to remain till morning. Spent most of the day outdoor, it being the first real pleasant day for some weeks.

Friday, April 25 Flora took me to Fairmount for early train. Left on 7:00 train for Marion. Called at Robt. W. Fryers in North Marion. Went on 10:02 train to Herbst. Saturday, April 26 Lit. Davis & family took me in spring wagon to Geo. Conways Dine there. Pr. at 2:00, 2 Pet. 1:3 Qr. Conf. followed. Pleasant session. Supper at Father John Carpenter's, 1 mile east of Burn's Sch. House 2 1/2 miles S. of Sycamore Corners. Rev. C. Rector pr. at 8:00, Matt. 22:37. I stay at Carpenter's.

Sunday, April 27 Called at Isaac Burns'. Pr. at Burns' Sch. House at 10:30, 2 Cor. 7,8. Dine at Ervin Coston's

near Jerome 2 1/2 miles west. Bro. Rector baptizes Young Burns & wife, and Bagwell Supper at Coston's. Burns and Coston are partly African. Pr. at 7:45, Mal. 3:16,17. A good love-feast meeting followed. Many spoke and the meeting lasted till 9:00. Stay at Father John Carpenter's.

Monday, April 28 Father Carpenter takes me to Sims Station. Write some postal cards to Muncie stewards. Go on to Marion & Ridgeville. Write to some of Elwood stewards. Arrive at home about 5:00, eve.

Tuesday, April 29 Write some editorials in the forenoon. In afternoon pay rent, and pay Mother Koerner \$10.00. Continue to write some. Wrote till late in the evening.

Wednesday, April 30 Rose at 4:00. Wrote for *Star*, during forenoon. Found in the afternoon that we were a colmn & a half behind. Provided this. Gathered letters & papers together such as I might need at Dayton and Germantown. Was quite worn down before I got to bed.

Thursday, May 1 Spent the forenoon in hunting up letters and reading proofs on editorials of the *Star*. Made up *Star* in afternoon. Spent evening in sending out transient copies of *Star*.

Friday, May 2 Got up matters generally. Went to Dayton in the afternoon. Saw Reuchlin & Lorin. Supper at Rev. W.C. Day's. Rev. H. Floyd there. His colloquy [sic] over Rev. H.W. Cherry's donation of \$6.000 to Seminary. Meeting of the Board of Education at 8:00. Considerable business done. Stay at Rev. W.C. Day's.

Drury's. Call at Davis'. Supper there. Called at Marcu's. He away. At entertainments of the literary societies at 7:30. J.C. Keezle's poem the best thing for the occasion. Stay at Dr. L. Davis'. He gives R. Rock a rocking. Rock said he never looked after his members, whether they were secretists or not.

Tuesday, May 6 Meeting of the U.B. Seminary Board. Dine at Mulholland's below Miami Chapel. Sister Edwards & Electa Mahan there. At board meeting in the afternoon. Supper at Recher's. Attended the lecture at Summit Street to hear Rev. Wm. G. Morehead lecture, on Students Tools. Stay at Recher's.

Wednesday, May 7 Attended board meeting at Seminary. Dine at Dillon's with Rev. J. Crayton. Attend Sem. Board meeting. It adjourned to meet next year. Supper at Rev. W.C. Day's with Bp. E.B. Kephart. Went to see Marcus my renter. He paid me one month's rent—paid up to April 4th. Attend the Alumni meeting at Summit St. Church. P.M. France, J.S. Sentman, and D.N. Howe spoke. Stay at Dr. L. Davis'.

Thursday, May 8 Called at David Huffman's to see Aunt "Tena" (Christina); also go to the pastor's study at arrange a circular for White River Ministerial Institute. Called at Wm. Dillon's—saw Jere Hoffman's widow there. Dine at S.L. Herr's. Went to Wm. Ferguson's in Dayton View. Got the names and dates relating to her father's family—Reuben Reeder's. Went to the *Telescope* office. Supper at John Gilbert's. Attend graduating exercises of Union biblical Seminary at Summit Street. M.S. Dovey, E.W. Bowers, J.S. Brown, S.D. Faust, W.O. Fries, B.F. Fritz, J.B. Hawkins, J.G. Hoffacre, J. Oliver

Fremont Spain, Jas. Turner, & L.E. Wilson spoke. Stay at Dr. Davis'.

Friday, May 9 Went over to east side. Bought a letter file. Rented pruner's property. Telephoned to Reuchlin to that effect Lunched at the Depot. Went on the C.C.C. & I. train to Miamisburg. On hack thence to Germantown, Ohio, to Meeting of Mission Board. Put up at A.K. Burtner's. Supper there, Rev. J.K. Billheimer lectured dryly that evening. I Lodge at Burtner's.

Saturday, May 10 Attend Board Meeting. Meet committee. Dine at Burtner's. Supper at A. Rodabaugh's. In afternoon, the effort to reduce *Oregon to Mission Dist. failed. Evening session before and after the annual sermon which was delivered by G.W. Funkhouser from Rom. 1:16,17. Stay at Burtner's. Burtner's children at home: Ida 18 ys.; Carrie 14; boy 10, Myrtie 7. The oldest daughter at Otterbein about to graduate in June, aged 21. *I had come to fight D.K. Flickinger's plan to reduce Oregon, but my effort was not needed.

Sunday, May 11 At Sabbath School after a call on Father Jacob Burtner's. Bishop Glossbrenner pr. at 10:30 Rev. "Behold I set before thee an open door," etc. Dine at Burtner's with Bishop J. Dickson & others. At Sabbath School address and Missions in the afternoon, at 3:00. Supper at Ezra Kenp's. Heard Mrs. Keister & Pike on Woman's missionary work, at 8:00. Stay at a Mr. Zehring's with Rev. Halleck Floyd.

Monday, May 12 Go to A.K. Burtner's before breakfast. After breakfast, take hack at Shank's for Miamisburg. Go on to Dayton. Go to 226 Zigler St. to see the corpse of David Louding, the colored boy from Africa, daughter's son of Chief Stephen Caulker. Dined at Recher's with the boys. Called at Rev. W.C. Day's. Went on 1:00 train to Richmond. H. Floyd along. Saw Jas. Martindale on cars. Says that White Water Association has about 250 members. The [unreadable] Baptist about as many or more. The churches rather diminishing within the past 25 years.

Tuesday, May 13 At home. Fixed up business in town somewhat. Sent off sample *Stars* to Parkersburg, Muskingum & Western Reserve preachers. Mr. Frindle came to look at house to rent if we got out—he and his wife.

Friday, May 16 Prepared & arranged for the first side of June *Star*. Went on 4:00 aft. train to New Castle. Stopped at Wm. C. Gowdy's, and tarried there for the night. Saw Harvey Root. Hi is rather discouraged with the propsects of the Church at New Castle. Find myself disappointed about getting a train at 6:30 in the morning.

Saturday, May 17 Called at Harvey Roots, Mrs. Eliz. Bowman's, Mrs. Betsy Schildknecht's. Went on a 9:00 freight to Muncie. Lunched at Restaurant. Rev. A.R. Day finds me a way to go out to Bethel—in Franklin Day's buggy—Call at A.R. Day's to feed the horse. Preach at Bethel at 2:00, I Cor. 13:13. A pleasant quarterly conf. followed. Supper at Joshua Null's. Pr. at 8:00, I Tim 2:6. I Stay at Null's, Rev. J.M. Cook & wife there also. Mrs. Randolph there, Mother of Horner Venneman whom Null's raised and of Lincoln Randolph, whom I stood against the door to learn him to stand 23 ys ago, now married and having two or three children.

Sunday, May 18 Pr. at 10:30, I Cor. 5:7. Communion followed. Two joined Church—Miss Huldah Iseley and Mrs. Lizzie Stephenson—I took them in the Church. Dined at John Hayden's near the Church. Call at Dr. Franklin Day's. She is a daughter of Rev. John Kiger's. At three, Rev. J.M. Cook baptizes 24 persons just below the bridge—one by trine emersion, a Mrs. Netzley. Supper at Null's. Preach at 8:00 John 7:37. Lodge at Joshua Null's.

Monday, May 19 Joshua Null takes me to Reed Station on Lake Erie & Western Railroad. Wait awhile at the store for a train. Go on 10:55 train to Muncie; then on 1:50 tr. to New Castle and on 3:20 to Richmond. Arrive at home about 5:00.

Wednesday, May 21 At home. Attempt to write some. Overhaul my files of Newspapers, etc.

Thursday, May 22 At home. Write some. Read up proofs and make up first side of June *Star*.

Friday, May 23 Wrote some in the forenoon. Got ready and went to Indianapolis on the 2:32 train. Supper at Walter S. Brown's, K. Elida Wiley and Mrs. Nannie Brown out on a visit in town. Stay at Rev. T.J. Connor's. He tells me from a letter that Walker Diffi is still raging

at Philomath, Oregon. Rev. J.E. Connor evangelizing on holiness on an undenominational basis. Bro. Jas. Edwards (Ore.) is much discouraged.

Saturday, May 24 Go on 7:15 train to Jackson Station. Stop at Geo. Rubush's. Rev. O.E. Evans, the pastor and Rev. W.C. Neal came; also Bro. N. Bentley & wife & Sister Huldah Purtee, Rev. Saml. Purtee's widow. I walked up to New Hope Sch. House. Pr. at 2:00 Rev 5:1. Seven Seals. Went up to Sharpsville and staid at Rev. D.P. Rubush's. His wife is daughter of Jacob Rubush with whom I had my home part of the time when pastor at Indianapolis in 1855-56. Her children are Clyde 12 years, Alice Ida 10, Carl 7, Ethel May 5, Leala 2.

Sunday, May 25 I rode down to New Hope to Coleman Quin's, with Rev. D.P. Rubush & boys. Pr. at 10:30, Ps 48:11,12,13. Communion followed. Dine at H. Tarkington's 1/4 S. fo Sch. H. He is nephew of M.E. P.E. Tarkington of Greensburg, Ind. pr. at 3:30 John 1:29. Walk down to Jackson Station. Supper & lodging at Geo. Rubush's. Their children are 11 in number. I had held a quarterly meeting a Jackson Station in 1861-62. I staid then at Redman's and perhaps other's houses.

Monday, May 26 Walked to Tipton Junction with Rev. E.O. Evans. Neal meets us there. Go on 9:30 train to Alexandria. Thence on 12:55 tr. to Fairmount. Prepare an article (finish) for *Star* on "Our First Frontier Mission," mail it to my publisher. Go to Anderson's & from there to Carter Hasting's. Mother Hasting had been much afflicted with eresipelas, etc. Supper there. Called at Robt. Hasting's. Then at John Smith's; he aged 76 ys. past. Rev. D.E. Myers' pr at 8:00, Rom. 8:3, an able sermon. Stay at John Smith's with I.M. Tharp. Mrs. McClure, Smith's aged widowed sister there. Her daughter was C.B. Small's first wife.

Tuesday, May 27 District Conference. Rev. William Hall on Minister's treatment of each other. Rev. M.M. Thomas on "What to do with regular appointments during revivals." N.L. Hoopingarner on Better attendance at preaching services. D.E. Myers on Missionary & other chart collections. I dine at John Smith's. Afternoon, Cyrus Smith on Increase of Biblical Knowledge among Our people. C.W. Rector on Conducting revivals. J.Y. Demumbrun on Attendance at Prayer & Class meet-

ings. Supper at Cell's. Sermon at 8:00 M.M. Thomas I Cor. 15:50. Cook's (J.M.) unique exhortation. Stay at Ab. Anderson's with Cousin Wm. Reeder who pays me \$38.50 next morning.

Wednesday, May 28 Went to town (Fairmount) with Wm. Reeder to the post-office & back with A. Anderson. Ministerial Association continues. Hall on Attendance at qr. Conferences & other business meetings. Wright on occupying our Cities. Myers reply & Wright's rejoinder Dine at Keever's. Question "box" and answers. Quite interesting. Topics continued Kethner on Christmas tree & other holiday entertainment. Wright on other churches occupying our houses with regular appointing & organizing in—our church houses. Supper & lodging at Elwood Davis's in Fairmount. Their Children Mary Alice Harvey (Colorado Springs) 26 Clara (Cheney) 22, Edwin C. 20; Willis 15, Charles 13; Albert Alfred 10; Constantine 8; Nancy 4. I.M. Tharp pr. at 8:00 Deut. 31:12.

Thursday, May 29 Session Sabbath School Convention part of the Distr. Conference. Rather hurried. Not very spirited. Called to see Mother Carter Hastings. She very much worried with erisipelas. Dinner at Robt. Hastings. Afternoon session quite good. Hall on Taking our own S.S. Literature. Milgrove chosen as the place of next year's meeting. Same time of year as now. M.M. Thomas on Home Reading Circle course of Study. Bell on Sabbath School singing Report of Com. on Resolutions. Supper at John Smith's with Wm. Hall and others. Evening experience meeting Good. I stay at Robt. Hastings with Thomas Bell & O.E. Evans.

Friday, May 30 Walked to Fairmount. Found the local train had gone to Marion. Went to Elwood Davis's. Tehy send Willis (Davis) to take me to Jonesboro. Mail article for *Star* on the noon train & go on tr. to Hartford City. Wrote considerable for the *Star*. Went over to Ft. Wayne depot to mail a communication for *Star*, but disappointed. Mailed it at Hartford. Heard Elder J. Maple speak on decoration day—short part of the speech. Saw Russel & David Stover & son Samuel. I went on 6:00 train to Red Key and thence with Frank Wonget & Rev. M.M. Thomas. Supper at Thomas's. Preach at 8:30 at Good Will Sch. H. Heb. 12:28. Lodge at Rev. M.M. Thomas' 1/4 m. west of Sch. House which is two miles

S.E. of Camden, Jay Co.

Saturday, May 31 Staid at Thomas' till about 11:00. Went to Peter McDaniel's for dinner. Pr. at 2:00, Rev. 5:1. Qr. Conference followed. Pleasant session. John Taylor Roberts recommended to annual Conference. Reports on salary short. Supper at Peter McDaniel's. Rev. Lorin H. Waldo pr. at 8:00, Luke 15:18, "I will arise" etc I exhorted. I stay at M.M. Thomas's. Their family are M.M. Aged 33; Sarah Eliz. 29; Ethelbert Lomax 10; Nancy Anna 8. She a half sister of Mrs. Elwood (Rachel) Davis—a Shugart, dau. of Henry Shugart, near Liberty Church in Grant County.

Sunday, June 1 I pr. at Good Will Grove at 10:30. Large collection of people. Communion. Dine at Bishop Addington's with Sutton's, Fuqua's & Hartup's. Rev. M.M. Thomas pr. at 3:00. Rain interferes. Supper at Rev. M.M. Thomas'. Mr. Ambrose Taylor takes me to the train at Red Key. I lodge at Mrs. Murray's boarding house till 3:00 morn. & take the fast train to Ridgeville. I had called at another "hotel" & heard the land-lord's tirade against Christians & left. Called at M.E. Church. Heard Rev. Mr. McKeg.

Monday, June 2 Awoke about 2:00. Went on 3:10 tr. to Ridgeville. Breakfast at the Sumption House, 40 cts. Wrote several cards. Went on 8:00 train to Richmond. Read some proofs on the *Star*.

Tuesday, June 3 Read up some more proofs on the *Star*. Made up the *Star* in the afternoon and got to wrapping and directing it. Also called to see Mother Koerner awhile.

Wednesday, June 4 Engaged in directing papers to subscribers, etc. all day. Finished about 4:00. Mailed a letter and card to Reuchlin on the 7:30 train. Felt quite tired. Slept perhaps 8 1/2 hours!

Thursday, June 5 Finished directing sample copies of the paper out. Spent some time in edditing [sic] communications and arranging for the 1st pages of next month's *Star*. In forenoon settled for programmes \$1.50 circulars \$1.50, and paid for seven quires of Manilla paper \$1.05, and \$23.60: Total, \$27.65.

Friday, June 6 I got ready and started for Fayette Co., via Dunreith, Rushville, Glenwood. Dined at Hotel at Dunreith, just south of Pan Handle depot, kept by Westerfield, an ex-Methodist, now Presbyterian. Went on 3:20 train to Rushville. There, when news came of the nomination of Jas. G. Blaine for President, I approved it, but disappointed of the nomination of Logan (afterward) for vice-president. Reached Glenwood about 6:30. Walked a mile & then rode with a Mr. McGrew to Fayetteville. Stopped awhile at Dr. Sipe's to see Estella Harris, my niece. Went on to Anson Moor's. they had gone to bed.

Saturday, June 7 Called at N.F. Bowen's. Visited the grave of my Father & Mother on the old home farm. Precious is the memory of their conspicuous integrity, affection & faithfulness. Dine at Anson Moor's. He takes me to Glenwood. I go on 3:17 train to Rushville & thence on 4:00 train to Greensburg. Found Granville Edwards and Miss Davenport on train. Go on 7:30 train to Hartsville Crossing, 3 miles N. of Hartsville. Go on Russel's hack to Hartsville. Lit. Societies hold a joint entertainment. Miss Laura Davenport, Elmer E. Fix, and Miss Fast among the speakers. I stay at Wm. Fix's—Prof. Fix's.

Sunday, June 8 Attended class-meeting at 9:30. Pres. C.H. Kiracofe pr. Phil. 4:8. Good discourse. Dine at Christian Godfrey Mensch's. At Sabbath School in the afternoon at 2:30. Few out on account of rain. Supper at Prof. C.H. Kiracofe's. Call at Roberts' and spend over a half hour. He a student from Blackford County. Rev. D.B. Keller pr. Heb. 11:6—evidences of Christianity. I stay at Rev. E. Pitman's with Rev. Halleck Floyd.

Monday, June 9 Called at John Anderson's. Attend a recitation in Language in Pres. Kiracofe's room. Dine at Rev. J.D. Current's. Board meeting at 1:30. Supper at Isaac Vansickle's. Rev. Sloss of Greensburg (Presbyterian) delivered an address before the literary societies. It was rather fragmentary, but good in ideas, clothed in good language, somewhat dramatic in portions of delivery, and earnest in manner throughout. In its tone it was manly and noble. I stay at Fix's with Halleck Floyd.

Tuesday, June 10 Board meeting at 10:00. Attended prayers at Chapel at 7:30, and had com. meetings afterward till board meeting. Dine at Jas. Funkhouser's (Prof.)

with Rev. H. Floyd. Board meeting at 1:30. A recess and Com. meetings. Resumed meeting of the board of trustees. Supper at Tyner's with Rev. A.C. Wilmore's wife & with Lizzie Billing and Miss Gordon, her niece. Board meeting at 6:30. Mr. C.N. Spencer delivered the Allumnal address at 8:00. A good address but articulation so rapid and imperfect, as to be more than half lost to the audience. Stay at Prof. Wm. Fix's.

Wednesday, June 11 Called at Rev. John Riley's. They are my old host and hostess with whom I boarded 31 years ago, now aged and feeble. Attended a meeting of the Board at 8:00. Subscription being the object. Considerable talk, but little subscription. Commencement exercises at 10:30. Music vocal & instrumental. Graduating addresses by Frank J. Bennett on Education by the State and by Alonzo Meyer on "What shall our Monument be?" Master's Oration by M.F. Daws on on [sic] "Our immortal Mission." Dine at Prof. S. Werts. Rev. A.C. Wilmore takes me to Hope. I go on hack to St. Louis Crossing & take 6:00 train to Cambridge City. At Cambridge I telegraph to J.F. Miller for leave to go home on freight train. Granted. Arrive at home about 12:30. (I then lived in Richmond.)

Thursday, June 12 At home arranging matters. I arrange for sending goods to Dayton, Saturday. Write Reuchlin & Lorin. I write to Clara & Samuel Wright to see if Clara can come & live with us. Buy ticket and mail letters on train. Engage what money we need of D.K. Zeller.

Friday, June 13 Went on 6:00 a.m. train (freight) to Ridgeville and thence by close connection to Hartford. Rev. N.L. Hoopingarner takes me to Wm. Knox's, who were from home, and thence to Samule Russell's where we dine. We go on to Bethel Church, 3 1/2 miles Southwest of Montpelier. I pr. at 2:00 I Cor. 16:2. Quarterly conference followed. Supper at John Kirk's, 1/2 m. east of the Church, with Hoopingarner. Pr. at 8:00 Matt. 19:27. Good congregation. Some went out & I rubbed them up somewhat in good humor. Stay with Rev. H. at Kirk's. Kirk's children: Retta & Ed.

Saturday, June 14 Went with Rev. N.L. Hoopingarner to dundee. I baptize Karie Robb and George Blount and George Bodine by immersion. Dine at John L. Russell's. Bro. Hoopingarner takes me on to Oak Chapel church

4 miles west of Dundee. I preach at 2:00, Rev. 5:1. Supper at Frank M. Baker's. I pr. at 8:00, I Cor. 1:23-4. Stay at John Stout's. Their boys at home are Wm. E., Geo, & John W. Our family shipped our goods today -Dayton, Ohio and Wilbur and Orville go over there.

Sunday, June 15 I pr. at Oak Chapel at 10:30, 2 Pet. 1:16. Sacramental service followed. I take up some subscription for the pastor. I dined at Jonathan Hodgson's. Supper at Samuel Jennings. Rev. Ben. B. Holcomb pr. at 7:30, on Jacob's ladder. Stay at W.H.H. Johnson's.

Sunday, October 5 Pr. at 10:30, Jas. 1:12. Dine at John Roe Jennings, with Rev. O.L. Wilson, Jas. Hutchens of New Hope class, etc. Rev. A. Rust pr. at 3:30 quite a good sermon. Went to Thomas Moody's near Lynn. Bro. & Sister Rust take supper there & then go on to their home at Farmland. 16:14-16 about Lydia.

Monday, October 6 Went on 7:10 train to Arcanum & the train for Dayton having gone, I go on to Troy. Visit Cous is Eliza Culbertson (Well south on Market St.) Call at Alex. Heywood's office & see him a few minutes. Call at Mr. Kelly's book-store but do not find him in. Went on 4:00 tr. home to Dayton.

Tuesday, October 7 At home. Mail papers—Oct. *Star*.

Wednesday, October 8 At home. Spend some time arranging my books.

Friday, October 10 Went on afternoon train to Richmond Call at D.K. Zeller's. Went on to Millville and thence to Rev. Jacob William's 1/2 mile north of town. Lodged there.

Saturday, October 11 Went with Rev. Jacob Williams to New Castle. Dined at Rev. D.O. Darling's at the parsonage. Call at Mrs. Eliz. Schildtknecht's. Pr at 2:00 I Cor 15:58. Quarterly conference followed. Supper at Rev. O. Jennings'. Rev. Wm. Davenport pr. at 7:00. Ps. 3:8. Stay at Nicholas Milligan's.

Sunday, October 12 Pr. at 11:00, 2d Cor. 7:1. Dine at O. Jennings with Wm. Davenport & wife. Call at Harvey Root's. Gowdy & wife there. Supper at Rufus Day's. Rev. D.O. Darling pr. at 7:00, John 1:10. Did well. I go to Merit Bailey's, 4 miles North-west, and lodge. He a son of Henry Bailey deceased. His widow, Rev. Anna Bailey, lives together with Merit.

Monday, October 13 Return to New Castle Call at Mrs. Mary Bond's—formerly Byers. Call a few minutes at Miss Baileys and Philebrows. Dine at Rev. D.O. Darling's. Go on 1:30 train to Carlos City. Walk most of the way via Rev. C.M. Smalls to Jas. Hutchens. Sup-

per there. He takes me on to Mrs. Louisa Cranor's. Stay there.

Tuesday, October 14 Go with Martin Cranor to Williamsburg. Dine at Herbert Pierce's. Walk most of the way to Washington. Call at Cyrus Osborn's and at Charley Gray's, the latter just up from a spell of fever. Went on 4:00 train to Richmond. Saw Henry Dowell & B.F. Straton on loaning money to W.H.H. Reeder. Staid at D.K. Zeller's.

Wednesday, October 15 Called on Dowell & on Stratton again. Went on 10:30 train to Anderson & thence to Fairmount. Rode over to Uncle Wm. Reeder's with young Howard. Staid there. He afflicted with cancer under his jaws, having had one cured on his lip a year ago.

Thursday, October 16 Go with Wm. H.H. Reeder Jr. to Marion to see about borrowing money to save an execution on Uncle's property. See Norton, Mather, Wm. White, Flynn, and several real estate agents. Call at John Mull's 2 ms N.W. of town. Go on via Jonesboro to Fairmount & Uncle's.

Friday, October 17 Go to Hartford with Wm. Reeder. Call at Parks. Dine at Rev. G.L. Mattox at Hartford. Go on to Cambridge City. Call at Amos Huddleson's. Supper at Cephas Huddleson's. Go with Huddleson's to Rev. F.M. Demunbrun's. Sister Demunbrun very sick. Stay at Huddleson's.

Saturday, October 18 Go on train to Richmond & thence on 10:30 train to Washington. Dine at Cyrus Osborn's. Went on with Warren Brooks to Sugar Grove. Comment at 2:00 on I Pet. 1:1—Qr. Conf. followed. Supper at Rev. O.L. Wilson's with Rev. C.B. Small's. Pr at 7:00 Acts 16:31. Stay at Alpheus Mindenhall's with Rev. C.B. Small's.

Sunday, October 19 Pr. at 10:30 Ex. 28:34. Small communion followed. Dine at Addison Wilson's with Small, Leonard's, Jonas Hatfield etc. Love-feast meeting at 3:00 led by Martin Coffman. Supper at Louis Smith's with Small. Pr. at 7:00 Luke 16:31. Stay at Rev. O.L. Wilson's.

Monday, October 20 Went on the hack to Washington and thence to Richmond on the train. Write at the de-

pot. Spend awhile in the Reading room. Call to see D.K. Zeller at his house to see the folks. Go home on the 2:05 train, to Dayton.

Tuesday, October 21 At home. Prepare copy for the outside of Nov. *Star*. Mail it on the evening train to Coe.

Wednesday, October 22 Write an editorial for the *Star*. At pr. meeting at Summit St.

Saturday, October 25 Went on 7:25 Morn. train to Straghton's. Eli Hawley takes me to his house 1 1/2 miles N.W. Stay there to Dinner. Rev. W.A. Oler also there. Pr at Salem Church at 2:00, Rom. 10:1—etc. Qr. Conference followed. Supper at Charles Hawley's 1/2 m. west of Elis Hawley's. Pr. at Salem at 7:00 John 21:17. Stay at Charles Hawley's.

Sunday, October 26 Go over to Eli Hawley's before meeting. Am at Sab. Sch. Pr. at 10:30 I Cor. 15:25. Communion followed. Dine at John Corber's. Wm. McGath & wife there also. Mary Smith, Wayne's widow. Pr. at 7:00 Rom. 2:6. Stay at Corbett's.

Sunday, November 2 Pr at Union, Ex. 28:34. Communion. Went with Rev. G.W. Fast & wife to Gellinger's 2 ms N. on Nat. road. Dined rhere. Rev. G.W. Fast pr at 3 1/2 "Let him not be ashamed." Suff[f]er as a Christian, etc. I stay at Joshua Lamott's.

Monday, November 3 Rise at 4 1/2, and walk 4 miles to Centreville to take the early train 6:30 + 20. Go on to Richmond & thence to Dayton. Help mail the *Star*.

Sunday, November 9 I pr. at 10:30, I Cor. 15:4. Dine at Parsonage, with Murphy girls. Speaking meeting at 3:00 Set Atkinson back. Supper at G. Fry's with Rev. C.R. Paddock. I pr. at 7:00 Rom. 4:10 "Therefore it is of faith that it might be by grace." Lodge at parsonage.

Monday, November 10 I go via Liberty to Daniel

Koerner's. Dine there. Came back to Union. Stay at Hoopingarner's till meeting time. I pr. at 7:00 at Union Eph 5:16. Lodge at Hoopingarner's.

Stay at Ronan's with Demumbrun, on the old Matney place Ellen Ronan, his wife, (nee Matney) once a pupil of mine.

Sunday, November 16 Pr. at 10:30, Ps 66:10. Dine at Bro. Jonas' with Austin Winchell's and Estella Harris. Stay there till meeting time. I pr. at 7:00 Heb. 11:6. Go with Ellis Wright my nephew to Anson Moor's.

Monday, November 17 Staid at Anson Moor's till after dinner. He takes me to the train at Glenwood. Go via Hamilton to home—Dayton. Made close connections. Found all as well as common. At request, called at Dr. L. Davis' and spent the evening.

Wednesday, November 19 At home. At prayer meeting at Summit St. Church.

Friday, November 21 At home. Dr. Davis called in the afternoon. Mrs. Rebecca Davis & Mary Inglehart call in the evening.

Sunday, November 23 Went to Grace M.E. Church and heard the pastor [blank] pr. I Cor. 15:56, "The sting of death is sin," at 10:30. At home till evening. Hear Prof. G.A. Funkhouser preach at 7:00 Joshua 23:11.

Monday, November 24 At home. This is the twenty fifty anniversary of our marriage, that having occurred at the home of her parents and of her Bro. Daniel on Thanksgiving Day November 24th, 1859.

Friday, December 5 Go on to Richmond Arrange for issue of the *Star*. Call at D.K. Zeller's. Go on 10:30 train to Ridgeville. Return to Winchester, and went thence to Selma. Supper at Henry Spangler's. Pr. at Selma at 7:00 I Thess. 5:18. Stay at Rev. J.Y. Demumbrun's.

Saturday, December 6 Went to John L. Jackson's and dined, Bro. Joseph Y. Denumbrun is along. Pr. at 1:30, Ps. 119:105. Quarterly conference. Supper at Henry Spangler's. Stay that night at Spangler's.

Sunday, December 7 Pr. at 10:30, Ps. 48:12,13. Communion. Dine at Edward Shull's. Father Davis, an aged layman dined there also. Called before meeting at Rev. J.Y. Demumbrun's. Evening meeting a love feast, led by Christian Life. I went home with Platt Mott's 2 1/2 north of Selma.

Monday, December 8 Speaking meeting at 10:30 led by Rev. J.Y. Demumbrun, the pastor. Pretty good. Dined at Geo. W. Ford's, with Platt Mott & wife & Edward Shull & wife & Sister Abr. Rust. Supper at Henry Spangler's. Pr. at 7:00 John 7:37. Stay at Rev. J.Y. Demumbrun's.

Tuesday, December 9 After breakfast, get my umbrella from E. Shull's & find myself too late to get on accom. train. Go to Spangler's & write a letter home. I go to meeting an hour. I dined at Henry Spangler's He is aged 72 years. I go at 1:00 train to Winchester & after two hours to Richmond. Mail a letter and a card home, also a letter to Rev. T.D. Adams. Called & staid at Benj. Harris', an aged man in Sevastopol, formerly living in the neighborhood of Williamsburg.

Wednesday, December 10 Went to Dublin (Cambridge) & called at Susanna Huddleston's. Dined at W. Scroggy's and arranged some business. Called at Rev. W.A. Oler's and at Rev. Halleck Floyd's. Supper at Dr. Geo. W. Champ's. His son takes me to the train at Cambridge. I call at Zeller's. I go on 9:30 train to Anderson. Lodge at Doxy House.

Thursday, December 11 I go on 6:00 train to Fairmount. Breakfast at Elwood Davis' I get his horse & buggy and go to Uncle W.H. Reeder's. Dine there. I pay off my tile

bill at Fowler's. Go in the evening to Elwood Davis's at Fairmount, & lodge there.

Friday, December 12 I go to Jonesboro on tr. and walk out to Geo. Carter's. Pay off note there. Bro. Carter takes me to Marion. Pay my land tax. I go on 11:40 train to Hartford. Thence on 1:20 train to Muncie. I get a letter from Susan. Go to Selma. I take Rev. J.Y. Demumbrun's horse and go via New Burlington to Mt. Pleasant. pr. 1 Cor. 5:7. Stay at Hez. Shuttleworth's 1/4 m N.W. at old Kiger house.

Saturday, December 13 Go to Philip Oxley's for dinner. Attend meeting at Mt. Pleasant at 1:30. Talk on Revivals. Held Qr. Conference. Supper at Harvey Jackson's 1/2 mile north-west. Pr. at 7:00, John 7:37. Stay at Harvey Jackson's with Rev. F.M. Moore, the pastor, & his son Arthur.

Sunday, December 14 Pr. at Mt. Pleasant at 10:30 Ps. 66:10. Communion followed. Dine at Huffman's a half m. S.E. It is rather rainy afternoon. Pr. at 6:00, Isa. 28:56. I lodge at Hez. Shuttleworth's with Milton Harris, one of our W.R. ministers.

Monday, December 15 I go back to Selma & put up at J.Y. Demumbrun's & stay till after dinner. I go on 1:00 train to Union & thence home to Dayton, Ohio.

Thursday, December 18 At home most of the day at least. Went to "town" before noon.

Friday, December 19 Went to "town" to see about my taxes. Found they must be paid not later than January 4th. Went on 1:00 train to Union. Applied for clergymen's rates on D. & U. R.R. and C.C.C. & I. R.R. Went on to Muncie. Walk a mile, ride 5 in a Sled & wagon, walk the rest to Olive Chapel. Find Sister Vienna Johnson preaching on the Lord's prayer. I Lodge at Rev. Arthur Rector's.

Saturday, December 20 Stay at Bro. Rector's and write an article for the *Religious Telescope* in the forenoon. Dine there. Qr. Conf. at 1:30. No preaching. Bro. J.M. Cook, the pastor, not there consequence of breaking his arm Nov. 17th. Supper at Bro. A. Rector's. Pr. at 6:30 Mark 8:38. Stay at Rector's again.

Sunday, December 21 Pr. at 10:30, I John V. 18,19. Communion followed. Dine at James A. Rector's 1/2 m. east. He is to move to Oakland, Vermillion Co., Illinois soon to carry on a tile factory with his sister's husband, Johnson. Sister Vienna Johnson, wife of Reuben Johnson of Bethel Church in Randolph County, preached at 6:30.

Monday, December 22 A speaking (lovefeast) meeting at 10:00. Real good. Dine at Arthur Rector's. Borrow his horse & go through the cold to Wm. H.H. Reeder's, my Uncle's 5 ms S.E. of Fairmount. He doctoring with Mrs. Moon for the cancer under his jaw. Lodge there.

Tuesday, December 23 Take Flora to her school and come back by my farm. I find the corn all gathered. Go on to Uncle's again before dinner. Get a letter from Uncle J. Braden, etc Consult that evening with Uncle & the rest what to do about his affairs. Stay there that night.

Wednesday, December 24 Go with Wm. Jun. to Marion. On the way, dine at *John L. Pegram's. At Marion met Jonathan Myers & wife & Rev. D.E. Myers; Also Rev. A.C. Wilmore. See about business and bear a letter from Baldwin, Mrs. Burke's attorney. Go on home via Jonesboro and Fairmount. Reach home about 9:00—that is Uncle's house. *Mrs. Pegram is James Milton Reeder's daughter, hence my second cousin.

Thursday, December 25 Went to Mr. Barritt's to see Mrs. Burke on a porposition concerning Uncle Wm's indebtedness to her. It was an eight-mile ride in the snow-storm. Returning to Uncle Wm's, find John Wilson Broyles and family there; Also Eliza Broyles and her children there. Went on to Rev. Arthur Rector's 4 ms s.e. of New Corner. Supper there. Sister Vienne Johnson pr. at 6:30 Isa. 40:31 "They that wait upon the Lord."

Friday, December 26 Went to Muncie in a sleigh with Arthur and Jas. Rector. Dined at A.R. Day's. He aged 70 married a wife of about 39—a fair woman apparently. Day takes me to the train. Go on to Winchester. There wait the train for Lynn. Went on 3:30 train to Lynn. Got a letter from home. Staid at Rev. Thomas C. Moody's 1/2 mile east of Lynn.

Saturday, December 27 Thomas Moody takes us in the

spring-wagon to Mt. Pleasant, 7 miles east, 2 1/2 miles from Arba. I pr at 10:30 Matt. 13:44. Dine at Wm. Manning's, 1 1/2 miles west. Qr. Conf. at 1:30. Had a pleasant session, only reports were short. Supper at Wm. Slick's, 1/2 m east. It rained out the night meeting—rained all night.

Sunday, December 28 Very rainy still. Pr. at Mt. Pleasant at 10:30, John 1:29. Communion followed. The rain somewhat abated. Dined, Geo. W. Slick, 1 m. N.W. of the Church. John Radford & wife there also. Pr. at 6:30, Luke 23:4. Went home with Wm. Manning's & staid there.

Monday, December 29 Bro. Manning takes me part of the way to Johnson Station. It being somewhat icy on his barefoot horses, I walk the last 1 1/2 ms. Go on to Richmond. Dine at Zeller's (D.K. Z's). Go on 2:05 train home.

Tuesday, December 30 I was at home, but made no note in my diary at the time.
