Wednesday, January 1 At home all day. Have cold and do not feel very well.

Thursday, January 2 At home till evening. Katie started to school in town. Called at Dillon's in the evening. Dr. L. Davis called awhile to-day.

Friday, January 3 At home all day engaged in assorting letters and in writing letters. Lorin, Wilbur, and Katie went to the Star course concert.

Saturday, January 4 Went to Richmond on noon train. Paid off Zeller's note. Went on to Dublin. Supper at Wm. McGath's. Call at Bp. Halleck Floyd's. Pr. at 6:30, Rom. 6:21. Stay at Dr. G.W. Champ's.

Sunday, January 5 Call at Oler's. All absent. Call at Floyd's. Pr. at 10:30, Ex. 28:34. Dine at Rev. Z. McNew's. Floyd & Oler call there. Went to Floyd's awhile—supper. Pr at 6:30, 1st Psalm. Stay at Floyd's.

Monday, January 6 Went to McNew's, and then to Cambridge. Go to New Lisbon (Sexton). Dine at Robin's. Thence to Hamilton's & to John McKee's. He takes me to Harvey Wright's. Lodge there.

Tuesday, January 7 Stay at Harvey's all day, and till morning. Supper at Luther New House's.

Wednesday, January 8 Harvey takes me early to Knightstown. Go to Richmond & thence to Dayton in evening. Saw Study. Called at Zeller's. Dine at Allen Harris'.

Thursday, January 9 At home all day. Mostly writing letters, reading, etc. Katie is better.

Friday, January 10 Went to town to see Houk & Study who came from Richmond; and again in afternoon. Wrote letters in eve. Called at Davis' in forenoon.

Saturday, January 11 Went to town to see Houk. Drew money on draft. Wrote letters and cards. Called to see Drs. L. Davis & Wm. Dillon in the evening.

Sunday, January 12 Rev. C.B. McDaniel pr. at 10:30, John 15:9. I Pr. at 7:00, 2 Cor. 5.19.

Monday, January 13 Rose early & wrote several letters. Went to Graybill's and Dr. Davis' and thence to R.R. offices & make application for clergy permits. At home in afternoon.

Tuesday, January 14 *At Conservator Office, Dillon's & Dr. Davis'.* At home most of the day. Settled with Lorin to Jan. 1st, 1890; allow him in all \$125.00 for five months. Paid \$20.00 on his trav. exp. home.

Wednesday, January 15 Went to Houk's Office in forenoon for copy of Dayton Answer. Rev. J.H. Kiracofe called in afternoon.

Thursday, January 16 At home part of day. Called at Houk's in afternoon.

Friday, January 17 At home in forenoon. Called at Dillon's & Davis' in afternoon. Telephone to Houk, twice.

Saturday, January 18 Went to Dr. L. Davis in forenoon. His deposition began on Church case. At home in the afternoon & evening, reading & writing.

Sunday, January 19 Attend Church at West End. Rev. Wm. Dillon preaches, 2 Pet. 3:9, a good sermon. Pres. C.H. Kiracofe pr. at 7:00, Ps. 1:1 4. Rainy evening.

Monday, January 20 At Dr. Lewis Davis' to see his deposition taken. At Rev. C.H. Kiracofe's in the afternoon. Com. from U.B. Sem. came! Rev. H. Floyd staid with us. Com. almost ashamed of themselves.

Tuesday, January 21 Went to town with Bishop Floyd in the Forenoon. At home in afternoon & evening.

Wednesday, January 22 Went to Dr. Davis, but Att's did not come. Call at Dillon's. Go to town in afternoon & get R.R. permits. Call at Court House, see Houk. Hear part of the pleadings in the Mc a fresh case.

Thursday, January 23 Go to town. Engage a coat & vest made. Call at the court room. Call at Dr. Davis' & Dillon's. Get ready to go to Orrville, Ohio.

Friday, January 24 Reach Crestline before day. Lunch. Reach Orrville ab. 9:00. Stay at Mrs. Sarah Shisler's. She well pleased with her donation to Church. See Mr [blank] Go on via Mt. Vernon to Centreburg. Stay at the Shaffer House.

Saturday, January 25 Go on 7:00 train to Rushville. N. Allebaugh takes me to his home. After dinner go to Zion Sch. H. & pr. at 1:30 1 Ps. 1 v. Raise \$304.50 for Zion Ch. defense. Stay at N. Allebaugh's.

Sunday, January 26 Pr. at Greyton Sch. H. at 10:00. Ps. 92:8. Raise \$210.00 for Pigsaw & Zion's defense. Dine at Wm. Greyton's. Allebaugh takes me to Rev. A. Bateson's. His son, & his Fatherinlaw, infirm. Pr at Otterbein 6:30, Ex. 28:34. Stay at Shaffer's John Shaffer's.

Monday, January 27 Went to Rushville with John Shaffer. Thence to Columbus, Delaware, Dayton, arri. at 4:00. Gather legal documents and start at 6:00 via Greenville

at Van Wert, Ohio. Arrive at Van Wert 9:00. Put up at Hotel Marsh, Room 33. Lorin with me.

Tuesday, January 28 At Court part of the time. Telegraphed to parties to come. Our case came up about 3:00. The pleadings were read. Adjourned counsel in Houk's room.

Wednesday, January 29 Began at 8:30 examination of witnesses: Miller, John J. McKenzie & Wilson after exam. of counseller & Dr. Steman. I on the stand an hour. Kiracofe testifies. Lorin went for record. Lorin brought books after a weary night.

Thursday, January 30 Floyd & Dillon testify. Afternoon, A.W. Drury & Funkhouser testified. After Supper, We had a meeting of brethren at Mr. Houk's room. A very unprofitable time.

Friday, January 31 Trial continued. McKee, Bay, Miller and Shuey testify. We have a meeting at 7:00 in Houk's room, No. 36. Not profitable.

Saturday, February 1 Shuey closed. Floyd and I recalled in rebuttal. Adjourned to 9th instant. Pay bills of Attorneys, myself, Lorin & Floyd. Go via Lima to Dayton. Get there about 9:00.

Sunday, February 2 Pres. Elder Wm. Miller pr. at 10:30 Isa. 66:13. Communion. Dine at Rev. Wm. Dillon's. Call at Dr. L. Davis'. Supper at home. Rev. Wm. Miller pr. at 7:00, Matt. 19:27.

Monday, February 3 Dayton Circuit Qr. M. at 9:00 at Dillon's. Prepare to go to Richmond. Go at 6:00 p.m. Put up at The Huntington House. Saw Kiracofe & Floyd at the depot. See Study at home. Lodge at Huntington House.

Tuesday, February 4 Court convenes at 9:00. Judge Kibbey dismissed the suit against Sugar Grove Church. Lawrence & Houk come. Consultation. Write letters. Go to Greensfork. Stay at M. Hatfield's.

Wednesday, February 5 Pr. Philander Cranor's funeral at 11:00. Acts 24:15. Dine at Martha Ballenger's. I take

the train to Greensfork & thence home. Arrive at 7:00.

Thursday, February 6 At home writing letters mostly. In the evening called at Rev. Wm. Dillon's & Dr. L. Davis'.

Friday, February 7 Went to town in the forenoon. Had Wilbur write letters in the afternoon. Took letters to the post office.

Sunday, February 9 Heard Bp. Floyd pr. at West End Church, 1 Cor. 14:8. Bp. Floyd, Pres. Kiracofe & Dr. Dillon in the afternoon. Rev. Floyd pr. at 7:00.

Monday, February 10 Went on 7:00 train to Lima & thence to Van Wert. Put up at Hotel Marsh. Col. Alexander spoke most of the afternoon & had Gunkel's brief partly read. Council in Houk's room (36).

Tuesday, February 11 Judge Wm. Lawrence spoke all forenoon & till 4:00 p.m. with great ability & power. Houk spoke two hours. Council again in Room 36. Mine & Floyd's room is 33.

Wednesday, February 12 Hon. John A. McMahon spoke till 11:30. We go via Manchester home. Arrive at Dayton about 7:00. Found all well. Judge Dennis Dwyer on the train.

Thursday, February 13 At home writing all day. Read some in the evening.

Friday, February 14 Write in forenoon. Call at Dillon's. Go to Town in the afternoon. The children go to the Star Course Concert. I wrote on an article.

Saturday, February 15 Write out article for *Christian Conservator*. Went in afternoon to see Mr. Houk who had telephoned me. He to go to N.Y. for depositions.

Sunday, February 16 Heard Dr. A.A. Willits pr. at Third St. Presb. Ch. at 10:30, 1 Cor. 12:31. Moderate preacher; witty lecturer. Call at Rev. C.H. Kiracofe's. I Pr. at West End Ch. at 7:00, Acts 17:30, 31.

Monday, February 17 Write in the forenoon. See G.W. Houk in afternoon and give him \$100 to pay expenses

to & in New York. Dr. L. Davis called in the evening.

Tuesday, February 18 Spent the time in writing largely. Sent list of P.E.'s to Dr. H.K. Carroll, Supt. Religions Census, Plainfield, N.J.

Thursday, February 20 Rev. W.O. Dinnius called in forenoon & Rev. C.H. Kiracofe. Wrote in the evening.

Friday, February 21 Spent forenoon in reading. Had letters written in afternoon. In the evening, called at Revs. Wm. Dillon's and C.H. Kiracofe's.

Saturday, February 22 At home all day. Wrote some. Read some.

Sunday, February 23 At Fourth Pres. Ch. heard D.A. Sinclair comment on Ps. 103:1-5. In the evening called on Dr. Lewis Davis.

Monday, February 24 At home in the forenoon, and at Dillon's & Davis'. Went to town in the afternoon & saw Houk.

Wednesday, February 26 Went to Davis', Dillon's, & Kiracofe's in the afternoon. Wrote letters in the forenoon & in the evening.

Thursday, February 27 At home writing part of the day. Bishop Becker came at daylight. I called at Dillon's with him. Exec. Com. (Mis.) in afternoon. Bishop Becker is very sick.

Friday, February 28 At Kiracofe's in the morning. Bp. Becker is better. Call at Dillon's. At home the rest of the day. Kenan's Lecture. Telegram of Judge Day's decision in Van Wert case. We learned it by letter in afternoon.

Saturday, March 1 Wrote an article for publication. Called at Graybill's, Dillon's, & Davis'. Judge Lawrence did not come. At home till evening.

Sunday, March 2 Pr. at West End Ch., at 10:30, Heb. 12:1,2. At home the rest of the day reading much in Chalmers' Sermons & Barnes' Notes. Much interested.

Monday, March 3 Went to Bellefontaine, consult Judge

Lawrence. Dine at a restaurant. Supper at Lawrence's. Go on 6:15 train via Sidney home. Arri. at 9:00.

Tuesday, March 4 Called at Graybill's, Davis', & Dillon's. Afternoon, called on Houk, & Geo. R. Young. Employed Young on the Dayton case. Evening: Called on Rev. D.H. French with Dillon.

Wednesday, March 5 At home all day. Wrote many letters in Afternoon and evening. In morning saw Judge Day's decision in Van Wert case, as published in daily *Journal*. Thermom. 20 degrees above.

Thursday, March 6 At home in forenoon. In afternoon, went to Houk's to meet him & Judge Lawrence in counsel. Call at Davis', Kiracofe's & McDaniel's. Ther. 7 degrees above.

Baker's, with M.F. Keiter. Rev. A.K. Shank pr. at 7:30, Ps. 1:1,2.

Friday, March 14 Conf. continues. J. Fohl & J.M. Bishop admitted. Bp. H.J. Becker came. Six are referred to com. on applicants. Rev. J.S. Wentz pr. at 7:00. At Baker's.

Saturday, March 15 Continue business. Afternoon, elect Keiter & Huber, P.E. Stationing Com. met at 7:00. Bishop Becker lectured at 7:30. Close Conference business. At Baker's.

Sunday, March 16 Pr. at 10:00, 1 Tim. 4:16. Dine as usual at Baker's. Sab. Sch. Anniversary at 2:00, at Lutheran Church. Supper at Baker's. Call at Hershey's. Missionary meeting at 7:30. Bp. Becker spoke. We raise \$410.00 subs. for missions. Becker's.

Monday, March 17 Go to East Crossing and walk down to W. Fairview & Dine & sup at Jacob Moltz'. Go on hack to Harrisburg and leave on 7:20 train for Pittsburgh.

Tuesday, March 18 Reach Columbus about 8:00; Xenia and home at 10:30. Revs. Dillon & Kiracofe called. Look over letters, papers, etc. Call at Dr. L. Davis' in the evening. Orville came home quite sick.

Wednesday, March 19 At home in forenoon. Call at Dr. Davis' in afternoon. Go to town & see attorneys. Call at Davis' again. At home in the evening.

Thursday, March 20 Called at Dr. L. Davis'. Went on 7:30 train to Greenfield, Ind. Mr. Howard takes me out to John Parker's, 6 ms. N.W. I Preach Father Parker's funeral at 2:00. Return to Dayton. Stay at L. Davis' till 1:00. He very sick.

Friday, March 21 Call at Dr. Davis' at 11:00 & stay till 1:00. At home in afternoon. Go to Davis' at 8:30 and stay an hour. Sleep five or six hours.

Saturday, March 22 Went to Dr. Davis' at 6:30, stay till about 9:00. Go to see Houk telegraph Floyd. See Young in afternoon. Stay at Davis' till 1:00 at night.

Sunday, March 23 Rose late. At home till 3:00 after-

noon. At Dr. Lewis Davis' the rest of the afternoon and part of the evening. He is near death's door. At 9:40 Dr. Davis died.

Monday, March 24 Called at Dr. Davis'. Saw Bros. Kiracofe and Dillon at their home. Return home and write some for the funeral occasion. Continue till 1:00 at night.

Tuesday, March 25 Write still on funeral papers. Funeral service at 2:00 at Summit St. Church. Text, 2 Cor. 4:7. Burial at Woodland Cemetery. Called at Davis'. Bp. Floyd & Rev. C.S. Miller come. Stay with us.

Wednesday, March 26 Rev. D.S. Buck comes. Go with Buck to cash draft. At home the rest of the day. Floyd, Dillon, Kiracofe, & Miller come in for counsel. Miller & Floyd stay with us.

Thursday, March 27 Went to town to see our attorneys. See them at library room. Call at Kiracofe's who are moving to Summit Street.

Friday, March 28 Judge Lawrence did not come. Called at Young's a moment & at Houk's office & did not see him. Writing some in revision of my sermon.

Saturday, March 29 Letters from Lawrence, Strawn & Norton, and Sheets & Ogan, and copy of a letter from Beeman.

Sunday, March 30 Rev. C.H. Kiracofe pr. 10:30, John 3:3. Wysong, Wood & wife join Church. I pr. at 7:00 Rom. 1:20. Three seekers at the altar.

Monday, March 31 Arose about six o'clock. Wrote some letters. Arrange to present a copy on evidence wanted, by Wilbur. Called at Graybill's, Dillon's, & Mrs. L. Davis' in afternoon. Wrote in the evening.

Tuesday, April 1 Went to town forenoon and aftern. Sent W.H. Reeder \$20.00 to Treas. of Adair Co., Iowa, \$40.00. Wrote Treas. of Grant Co., Ind. inquiring. Lent C.H. Kiracofe \$300.00 on Mortg. notes as collateral.

Wednesday, April 2 At home. Wrote some notes on evidence, etc., etc.

Thursday, April 3 Went to town. Saw Young & Houk. Rev. C.H. Kiracofe spent afternoon with me looking up evidence, etc.

Friday, April 4 Called in Court room in forenoon. Called again in afternoon and made out affidavit in New Castle case. Attend Willett's lecture in evening.

Sunday, April 6 Hear Rev. C.B. McDaniel pr. at 10:30, West End Ch., Isa. 9:6—"the everlasting Father." Attend Gen. Class meeting at same afternoon.

Tuesday, April 8 Consultation of Lawrence, Houk & Young, and agreement between them & liberal lawyers.

Friday, April 11 At home mostly. Saw Kiracofe at his house. Called at Dillon's in the evening. Kiracofe starts for Chicago 9:00 +.

Saturday, April 12 At home in forenoon. Felt exhausted. Wrote & had written a number of letters. Went to town. Saw Houk and Young.

Sunday, April 13 I pr. at W. E. Ch. at 10:30, Ps. 94:7. At home all the rest of the day & evening. Read largely in Barnes' Notes, etc.

Monday, April 14 At home in forenoon. Saw Young and Houk in the afternoon. Planned for the week. At home in the evening.

Tuesday, April 15 Wilbur went to Bellefontaine. Lorin went to Dublin, Andersonville, etc.

Wednesday, April 16 At home. Lorin returned home from Indiana in the afternoon.

Thursday, April 17 At home mostly. Letter from Lawrence & from Wilbur.

Friday, April 18 Went to Cincinnati on the 8:10 train with Geo. R. Young, Esq. He argues the question of jurisdiction of U.S. Court of Pr. House case. Dine at Gibson house. Take Bp. Waldon's deposition. Come home on 6:00 train.

Monday, April 21 At home forenoon & afternoon. Rev. Wm. Miller called in the evening & I went with him to Prof. C.H. Kiracofe's on Summit Street to consult on time & place of our Anniversaries.

Thursday, April 24 At home in forenoon, part of the time. Called at Young & Houk's in the forenoon also.

Saturday, April 26 At home all day. Pres. C.H. Kiracofe called in the afternoon. Had seen Drs. Betton & Warfield, at Princeton, N.J.

Sunday, April 27 Attended Church at West End Chapel & heard a sermon by C.B. McDaniel the pastor. At home all the rest of the day.

Wednesday, April 30 Wilbur & Orville started their daily, the *Evening Item*. Had a counsel at Rev. Kitacofe's, with him & Dillon on Board Meetings.

Thursday, May 1 Began my deposition in the Pontiac, Illinois case. Cross questioning began at about 3:30, perhaps. Meeting of the Ex. Com. of Mis. B. at 7:30.

Monday, May 5 Went to town in the afternoon. Mr. Young gone to Columbus. Saw Mr. Houk.

Tuesday, May 6 Went to see Mr. Young. He at Cin. Got home 5:30. Called in forenoon & spoke a few words with Mr. Houk.

Wednesday, May 7 Petoskey depositions not arranged for to-day, somehow. Wrote many letters in the afternoon and evening.

Thursday, May 8 G.W. Houk called in the forenoon. Kiracofe called in the afternoon is going to Burbank, O, to-morrow. I wrote an article on "The Communion of Saints."

Friday, May 9 At home all day. Wrote many letters. Rev. H.H. Hinman called. He is arranging for a Church Union Convention.

Saturday, May 10 At home in forenoon. Called over in afternoon for Petoskey plaintiff depositions. Doubts about the legality. Adj. till Monday at 10:00.

Sunday, May 11 At home all day. Spent it closely in reading. Read mostly Religious anecdotes.

Monday, May 12 Called to town, but deposi. put off till 2:00. Spent about 3/4 of an hour in afternoon on W.J. Shuey's depositions.

Tuesday, May 13 - Wednesday, May 14 [Worked] on Shuey's deposition. Wilbur went to Bell[e]fontaine.

Thursday, May 15 At home most of the day writing. Wrote some items for Conservator. Called in the evening at Dillon's, Davis' and Kiracofe's.

Friday, May 16 Wrote some cards and a letter to Lawrence & mailed them in town. Felt unwell in afternoon and evening.

Saturday, May 17 Went at 11:00 to Sidney & thence to Quincy. Supper at Rev. J.H. Kiracofe's. Lodge at Rev. S.L. Livingston's 2 m. south. Children: Stanley 14, Clifford 13, Chester 9, Nellie 7, Edith 4.

Sunday, May 18 Pr. at Union at 10:30 (11:00) John 12:43. Dine at David Shanely's 1/2 m. N.E. It rains & I do not go to Carysville with Kiracofe but go back to Livingston's.

Monday, May 19 Go to early train at Pemberton & thence to Sidney & Dayton. Read proofs. See Young & Houk and arrange for Young to go to Richmond. Go to Xenia & see Dr. Cardon. Come home.

Tuesday, May 20 Get ready & start to Richmond, Ind., at 11:20. Put up at Huntington House. Confer with Lawrence, Study, & Young afternoon & awhile in the evening.

Wednesday, May 21 Consult with lawyers. Dinner at D.K. Zeller's. Afternoon again at T.J. Study's office. Supper & lodging at Hotel.

Thursday, May 22 Judge Bundy did not come till 5:00 p.m. & then put off the church suit till June 23d. I dined at D.K. Zeller's & staid there at night. Lunched at a restaurant.

Friday, May 23 Start at 9:00 for Liberty & Lotus. Dine with Rev. J. Selig at Clinton Brattain's. Supper & lodging there. Children: Gertrude 13, Grace 7, Benjamin 20 months.

Saturday, May 24 Start at 10:00, for Danl Koerner's. Dine there. Pr. at 2:00 at Franklin Church, Acts 1:14. Supper at Daniel Harbine's. Children: Morris 9, Nellie 5. Pr at F. at 8:00, Heb. 2:3. "Lo great Salvation". Stay at Henry Fry's. Their daughter Anna, aged 14.

Sunday, May 25 Pr. at 10:30 (Whitsunday sermon) Joel 2:28. Dine at Jacob Wooter's 3 ms N. Rev. John Selig pr. at 4:00, Luke 7:27, 28. Rev. C.M. Paddack takes me

to Liberty. Stay with Will Stanton. Attend M.E. Church & hear Rev. Ashman Lecture. Henry Burt lives in Liberty.

Monday, May 26 Start on 6:00 A.M. train for Hamilton and Home. Arrive about 10:00. At home the rest of the day.

Tuesday, May 27 At home in forenoon. Call on Young & Houk in the afternoon. Home in the evening.

Wednesday, May 28 At home all day. Quite poorly and did not do much. Wrote a few letters in the evening.

Thursday, May 29 Lorin went at 10:25 to Cincinnati to see about printing Lawrence's Brief. He got home on a late train.

Friday, May 30 I tried to write an article for the *Conservator*, but was too unwell. Prof. Kiracofe called in the forenoon. Decoration day.

Saturday, May 31 Went to town to have my teeth plate fixed. Was unwell. Mrs. Miller helped Katie clean house.
