Camp near Corinth Miss. June 1st 1862

My dear Cousin Mattie,

Yours of the 10th nlt, was only received to day, being the first letter I have had from you, for months, the mail have been very irregular indeed. I am now in excellent health, have just returned from Corinth, which you know is evacuated. I have not time to write particulars, you will have read all before this time in the public Journals. I am writing by a poor Candle at the Guard House, being on duty there.
