0:09 Mental Illness Intellectual  
0:10 Disability. Today we're going to  
0:12 talk about Ohio's telepsychiatry  
0:14 project for MIID, which was  
0:16 initiated in 2012. All  
0:19 individuals with ID need and  
0:21 deserve the highest quality  
0:22 resources and should have access  
0:24 to state-of-the-art medication  
0:26 regimens, excellence and  
0:27 adaptive psychotherapy and  
0:29 comprehensive case management.  
0:31 The Ohio Department of  
0:32 Developmental Disabilities and  
0:34 the Ohio Department of Mental  
0:35 Health and Addiction Services  
0:37 both fund the statewide resource  
0:39 for ID. These services are  
0:41 available to all persons in Ohio  
0:43 who are linked with their county  
0:45 board of DD services, and you  
0:47 have a mental health condition,  
0:48 or suspect there may be a mental  
0:50 health condition and would  
0:51 benefit from evaluation by a  
0:53 specially trained child,  
0:54 adolescent or adult  
0:55 psychiatrist. We use virtual  
0:58 appointments to help us overcome  
0:59 issues like uneven distribution  
1:01 of resources and lack of  
1:02 infrastructure in certain areas  
1:04 of the state. It really does  
1:06 help to even the score so to  
1:07 speak. The show rate is higher  
1:10 and the cancellation rate is  
1:11 lower when compared to face-to-  
1:12 face doctor visits. Some patients  
1:14 just feel more comfortable  
1:15 sharing sensitive information  
1:17 during webcam visits, especially  
1:19 when they're meeting from a safe  
1:20 and preferred location of their

1:22 choice. We have decreased  
1:24 emergency room visits,  
1:25 hospitalizations, travel costs  
1:28 and DC readmissions. Nearly 400  
1:31 of our patients spend at least  
1:32 one full year in a DC prior to  
1:34 joining the project, and all  
1:36 have been living in the  
1:37 community where they belong for  
1:39 at least one year since joining.  
1:41 We offer one time second opinion  
1:43 assessments or ongoing care. We  
1:46 currently serve over 1,800  
1:47 patients from 83 counties across  
1:49 the state. We use compliance  
1:51 software platforms that protect  
1:53 patient privacy. We can securely  
1:56 link parents or guardians from  
1:57 different locations into the  
1:58 appointment, you just click on a  
2:00 link in an email and you can  
2:02 join from the comfort of your  
2:03 work or home setting. The Ohio  
2:06 Department of Developmental  
2:07 Disabilities and the Ohio  
2:09 Department of Mental Health and  
2:10 Addiction Services are committed  
2:13 to serving individuals with ID  
2:15 as well as their families,  
2:16 caregivers, and treatment teams.
