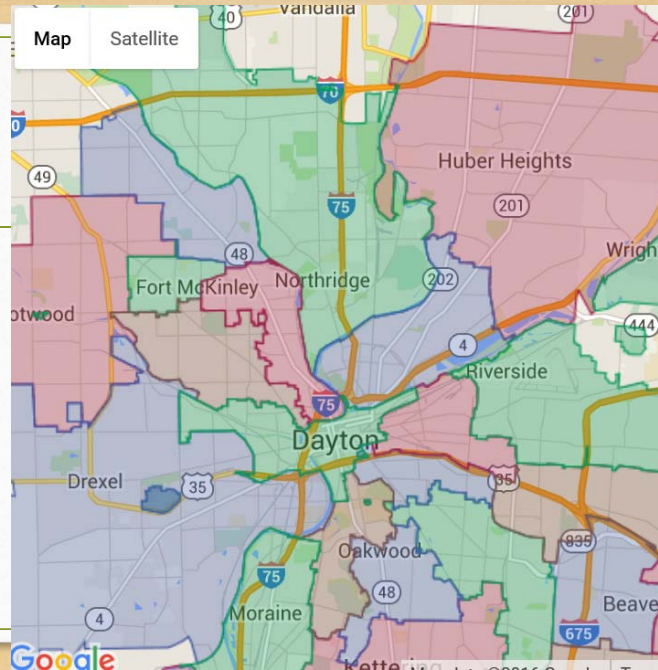
Purpose of Assessment

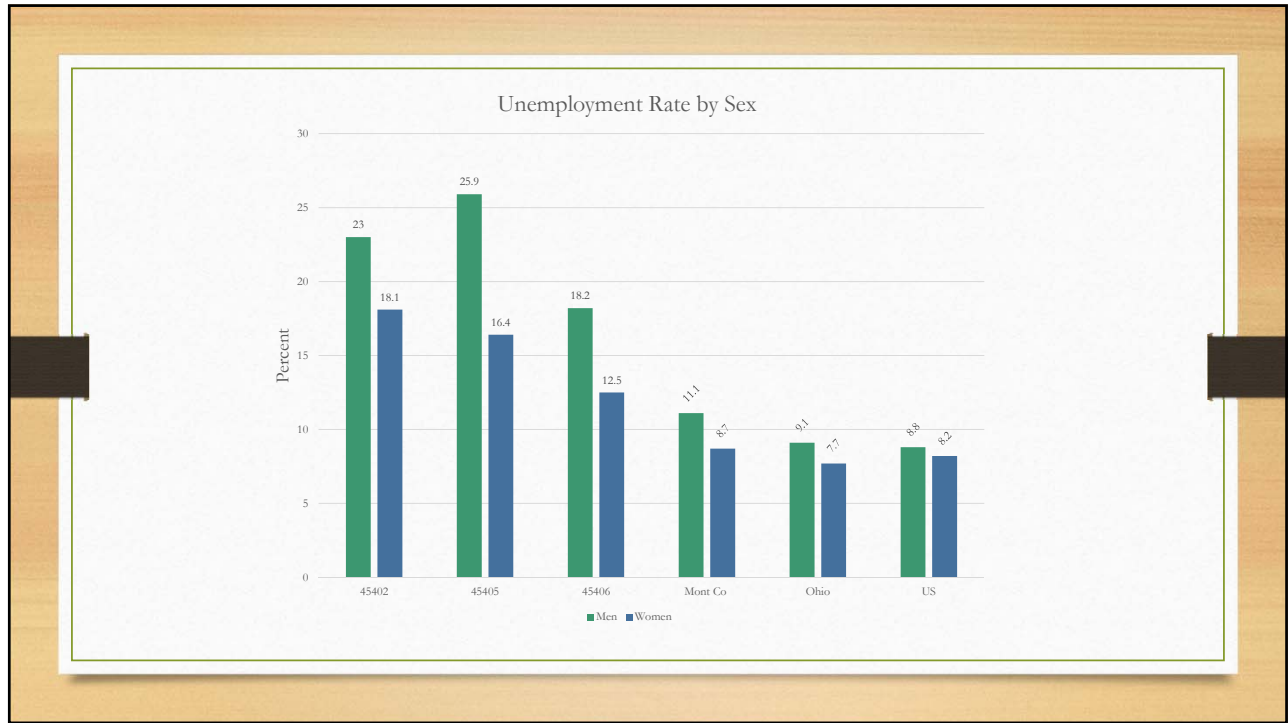


Neighborhood



Unemployment

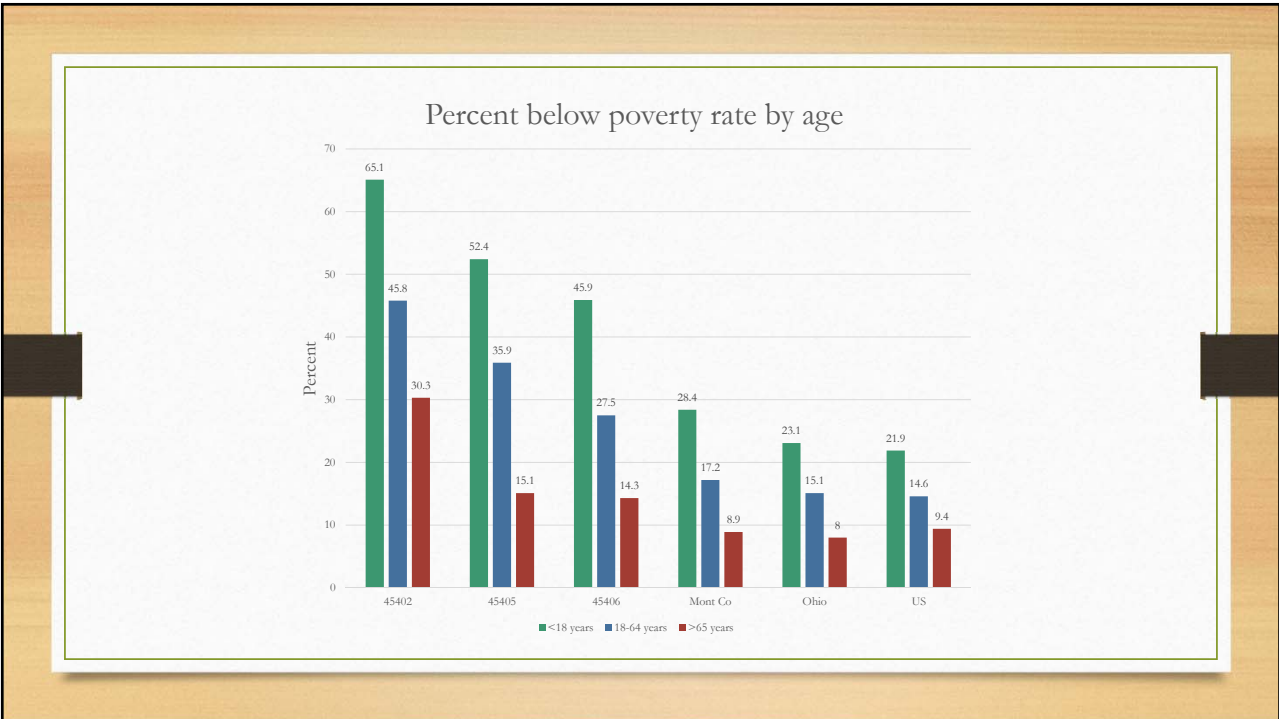
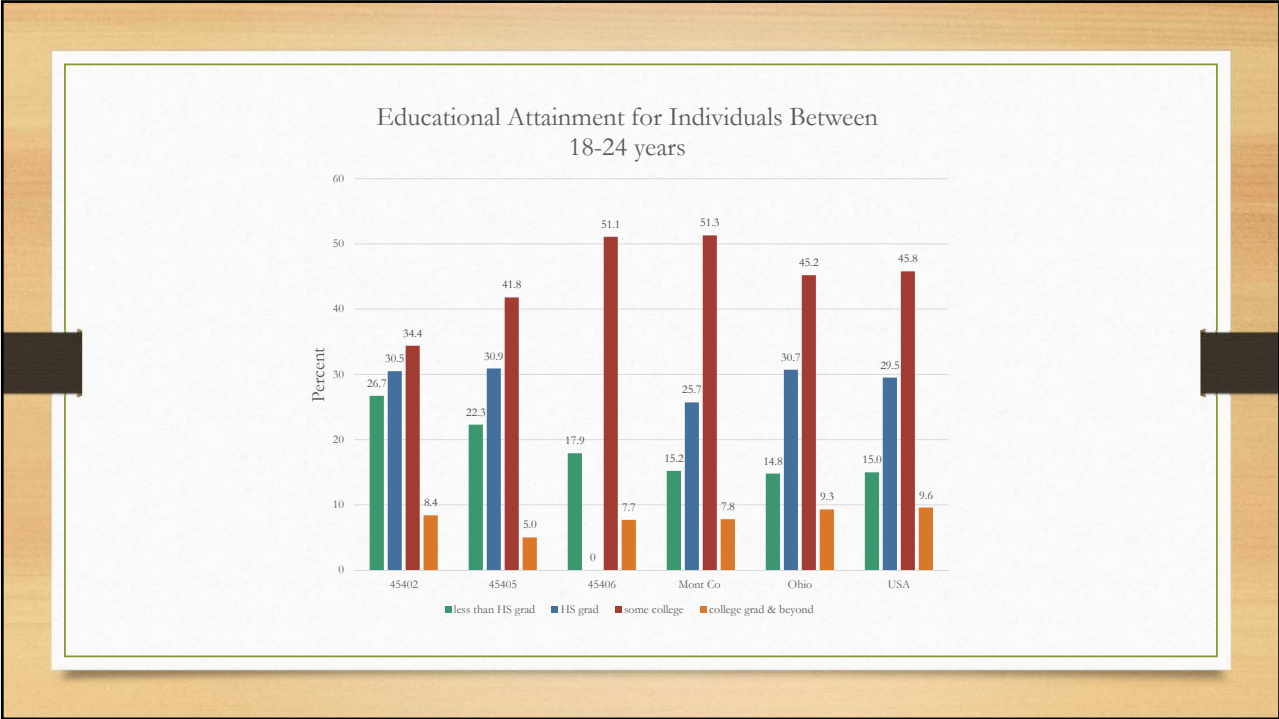




School Performance Indices

compared to other schools in Ohio by ODE

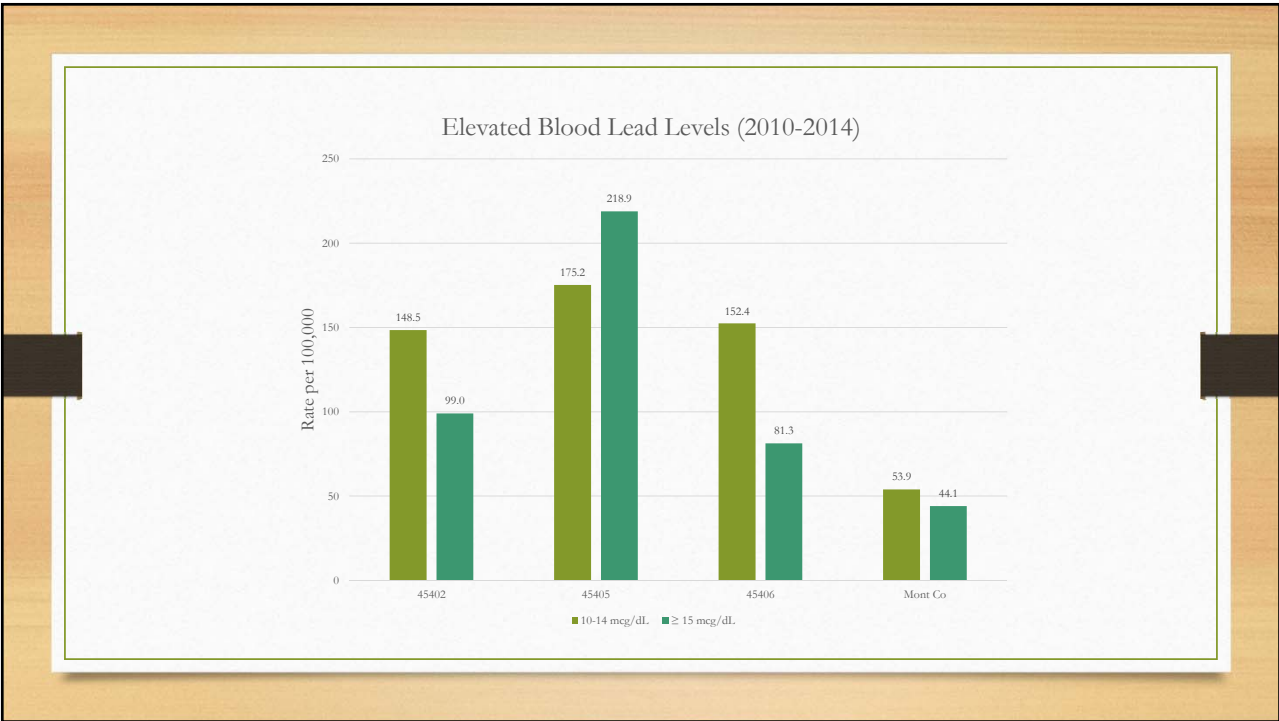
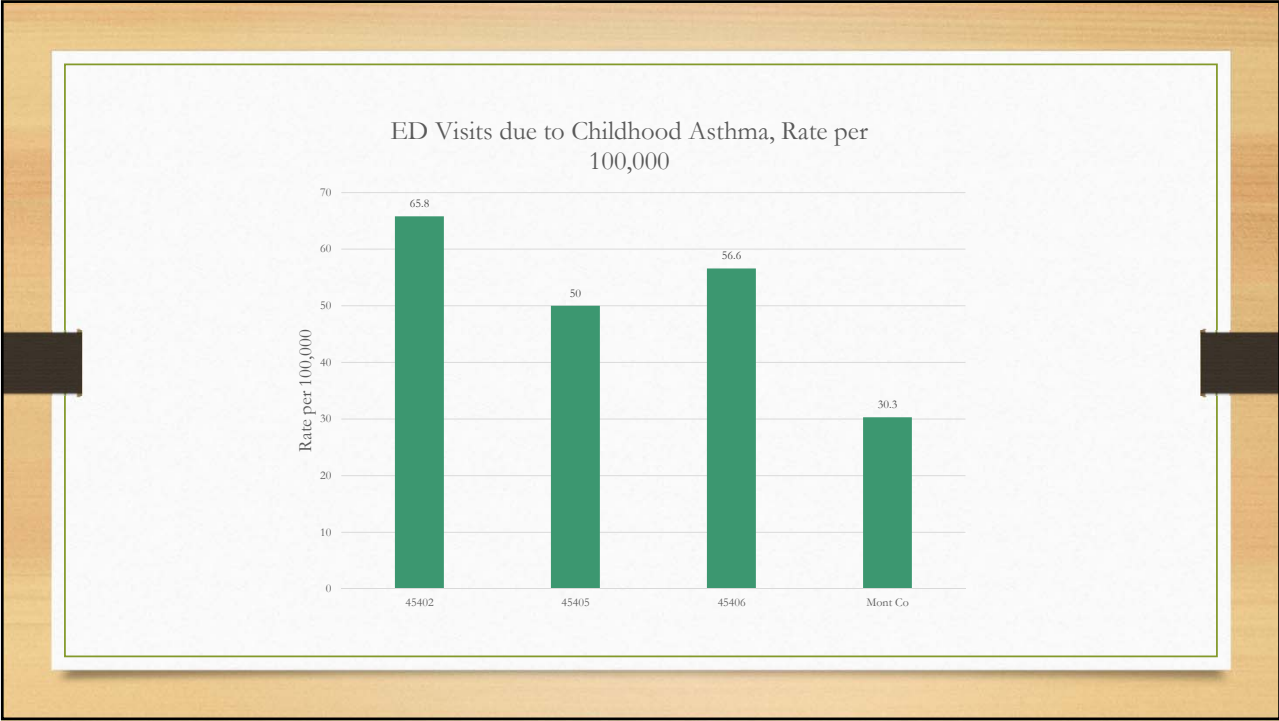

45406	4	3 schools = D 1 school = F

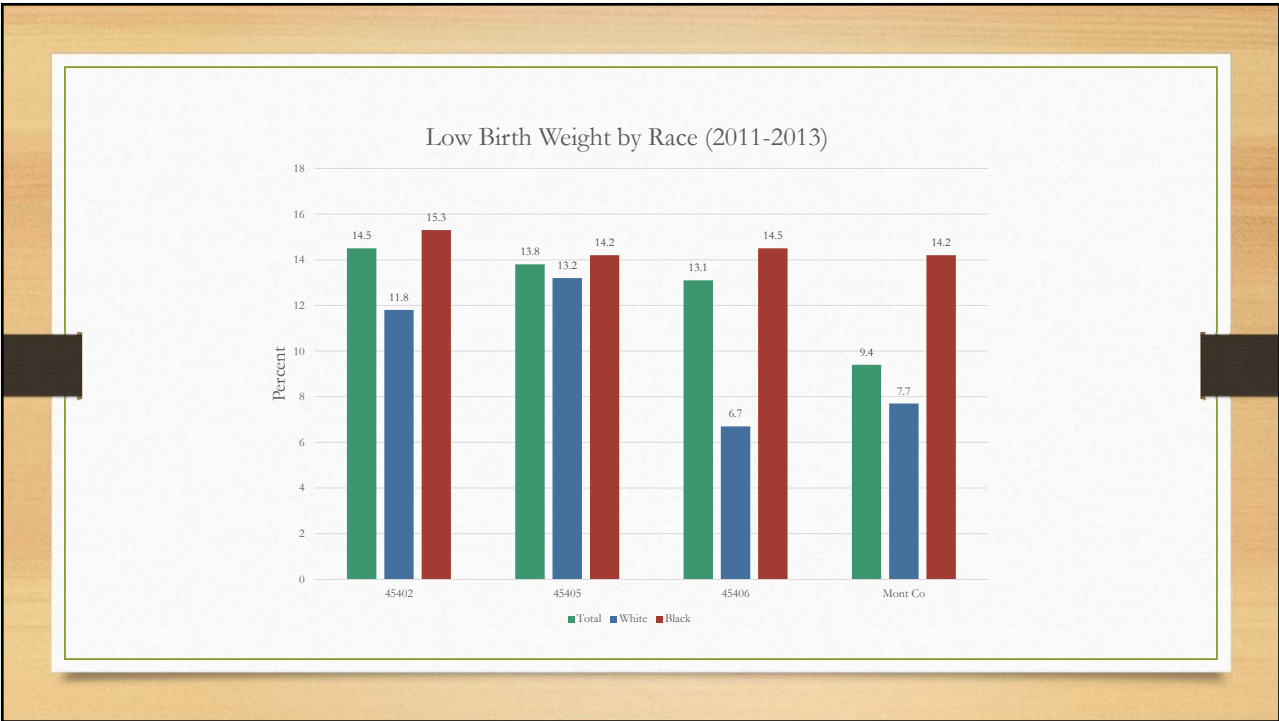
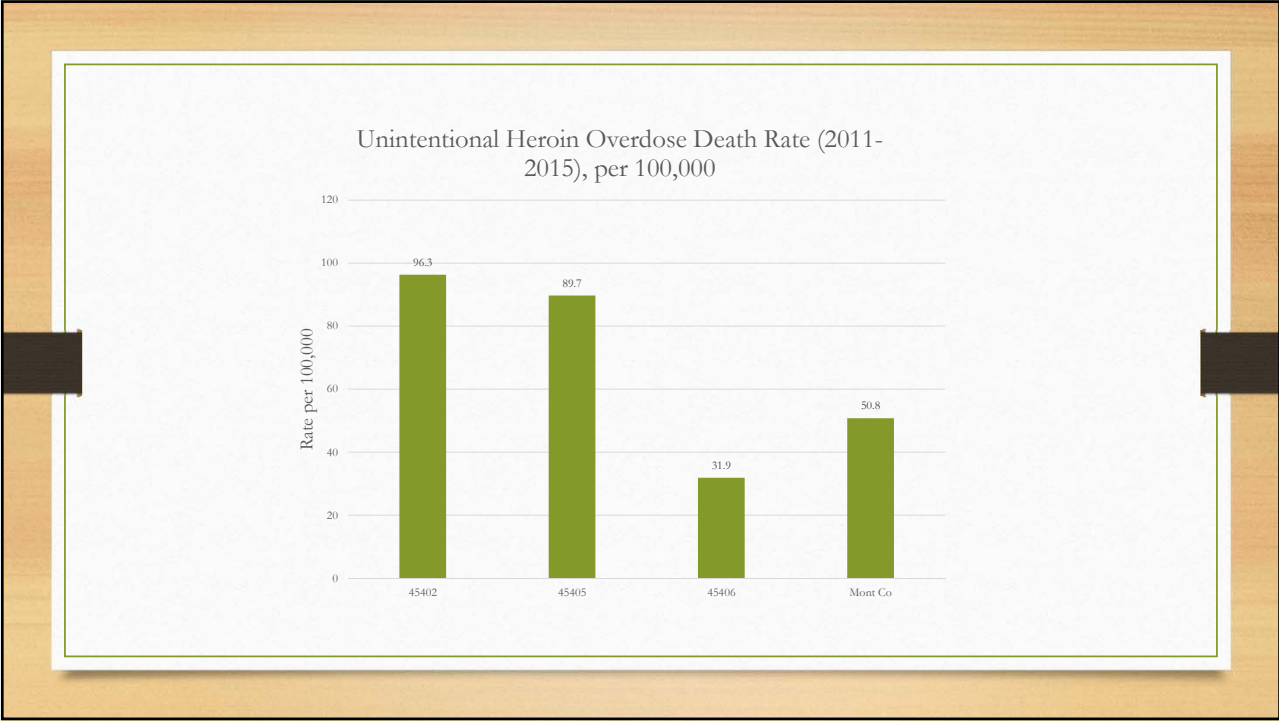


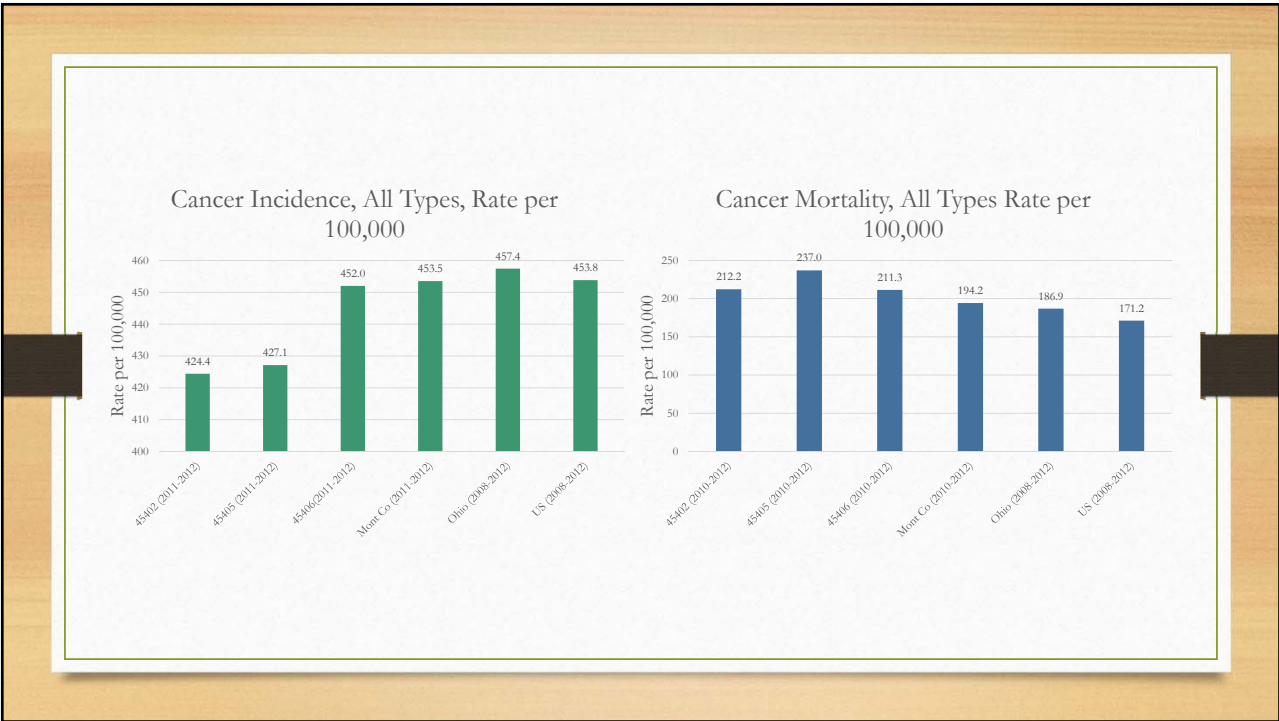
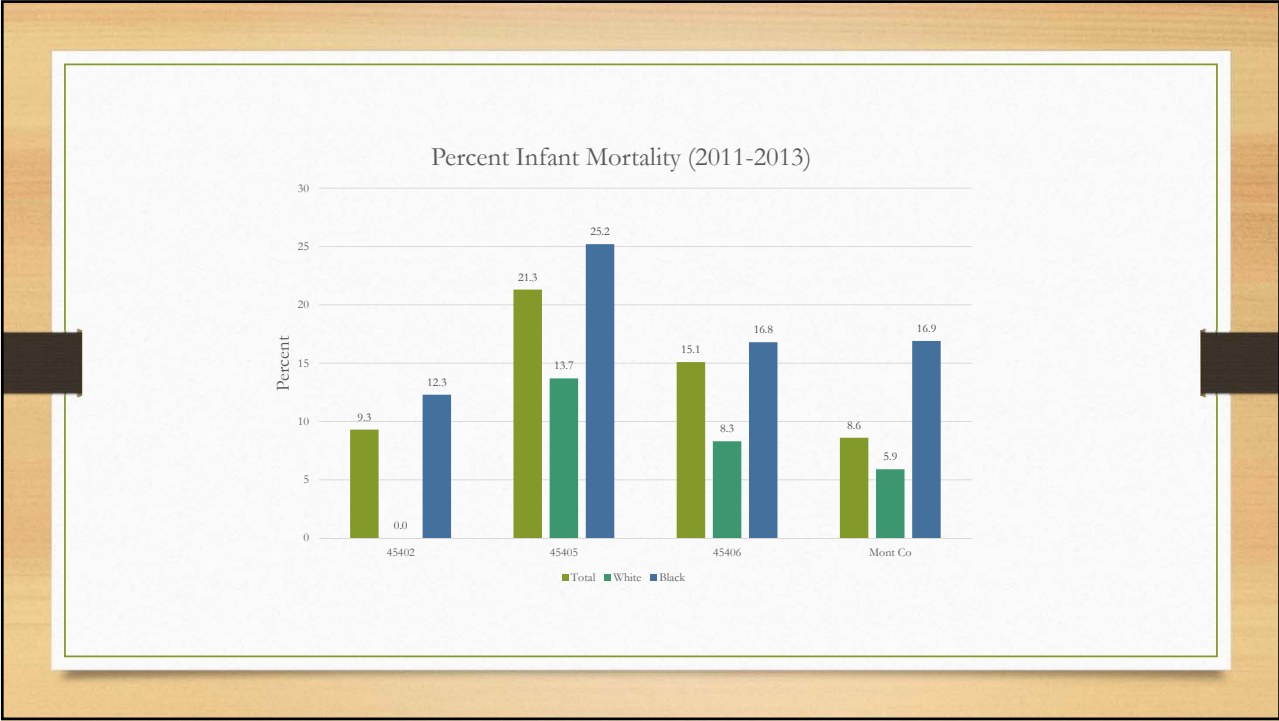


Health Indicators

 - Social determinants of health
 - Education
 - Infant health
- Collaboration between FRFHC and public health is required to reduce these disparities

Recommendations

FRFHC

- Education – refer to the Ladder
- Asthma – allergens and asthma emergency plan
- Screen for drug use – naloxone strategy
- Prenatal care
- Screenings for cancer

Public Health

- Housing
- Child poverty
- Naloxone strategy
- Parenting/breastfeeding support
- Screenings for cancer
